Warning

- Read all instructions before assembling and using this product.
- Failure to follow these instructions could result in serious injury or death.
- Adult setup only.



No diving, running, jumping, or horseplay in or around the pool.



DO NOT sit on, jump on, or straddle the sides of the pool.



DO NOT use the pool as a flotation device.



DO NOT leave children unattended.



DO NOT over inflate or use high pressure air to inflate this product.



DO NOT USE in extreme weather conditions, including but not limited to: wind and rain.



Use ONLY on level ground, free of debris.

Empty and store SAFELY when not in use. Pool fencing laws may affect this product, please contact your local council for further information.

CLOSELY SUPERVISE CHILDREN. Use under competent supervision ONLY.

WARNING: Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or death.

Inflate and Setup

Read warning label and user manual before setup and first use.

ADULT SETUP ONLY

1. Unfold pool, then use the small attachment on the included pump to inflate the pool floor. Do this first before inflating the sides.
2. Next, use the medium attachment to inflate the three side valves. Close once filled.
3. Fill with water and have a blast!

WARNING: Do not over inflate or use a high pressure inflator.

Deflate and Put Away

1. When you're done, open the drain plug on the pool floor and empty all of the water.
2. Open the side valves to release the air.
3. Use the large attachment on Deflate to empty air from all remaining valves.
4. Once the pool is dry and deflated, fold it up and store in the provided bag in a dry, cool place.

Failure to follow these storage instructions may result in color fading and wear on the material. Please check the product periodically.

Please note, the pump may overheat with extended use. If it starts to feel too hot, turn it off and let it cool down.

Care

- Set up on an open flat surface, free of items that could puncture your pool.
- Do not over inflate. This will tear seams and create premature leaks.
- Take temperature into account when inflated, air will expand in heat. Monitor inflation levels throughout use.
- Do not apply excessive pressure to the pool, specifically the rings. This includes but is not limited to: sitting, jumping, and excessive leaning or pushing on them.
- Always use the drain to empty the pool. Clean off any dirt or debris that came into the pool during use.
 - Trying to flip the pool can cause tears.
 - If the pool does get dirty, clean with a gentle, non-toxic soap.
 - When not in use, store completely dry in a cool location.
- Check product periodically before use to ensure there are no leaks, holes, or punctures. If so, please do not use the pool.
