

PORTABLE BATTING CAGE WITH FRAME INSTRUCTIONS

WARNINGS!

This is not a toy. Make sure people, especially children, do not climb on or stand around or behind the batting cage at any time. When in use, the batting cage must be located in an area where its use cannot cause damage to persons and/or property. Make sure there is no person or property in the batting cage during its use other than the batter and, if using a protective screen, a pitcher.

Batting helmets must be worn at all times when using the cage. When pitching to a batter inside the cage, always use a protective L-screen or safety screen to prevent injury to the pitcher.

Any failure by the consumer to follow the installation instructions and the warnings set forth above will make the batting cage unsafe and harmful to persons or property. Any use of the batting cage is at the consumer's own risk.

Wind Support: Rope or ground fasteners should be used to anchor the cage frame to the ground. This cage weighs over 300 pounds but wind will flip it over and cause damage to the frame if not secured.

PORTABLE BATTING CAGE WITH SNAP PIN FRAME DESIGN

60' LONG x 10' HIGH x 10' WIDE AT TOP & 12' WIDE AT BOTTOM

PARTS LIST:

- (1) 60'Long x 10'High x 10'Wide at top and 12'Wide at bottom Batting Cage Net
- (1) Heavy Duty Impact Net
- (33) pcs Frame Pipe "A" with snap pin
- (33) pcs Frame Pipe "B" with hole for snap pin at one end
- (10) 4-way steel corners with tightening screws
- (4) 3-way steel fittings for top of frame
- (66) pcs bungee balls
- (14) pcs end cap floor protectors to fit on bottom of frame pole legs "A"

SPECIAL NOTE:

When tightening fittings, <u>do not</u> use tools. Fittings should be hand tightened only or screws may break.

When using the Batting Cage, install the impact net to the cage so that it hangs loose like a curtain so that the netting can absorb the impact of the ball.

WARNINGS

Note: The impact net is a consumable item. Life expectancy is dependent on usage. For questions regarding assembly or for replacement items, contact Allsports US, Inc. (888) 230-0494.

We are not responsible for any damage due to weather conditions such as wind, snow build up, etc. Take cage (including frame) down when not in use for long periods of time. In the event of high winds the net and frame should be taken down to prevent damage and/or injury.





ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS FOR PORTABLE BATTING CAGE WITH SNAP PIN FRAME DESIGN


STEP # 1 LAYOUT ALL FRAME PIPES ON GROUND (SEE DIAGRAM # 1). YOU CAN ALSO FOLD DIAGRAM # 1 ON THE DOTTED LINES TO MAKE A THREE-DIMENSIONAL MODEL.




STEP # 2 ATTACH ALL FRAME PIPES AND FITTINGS TOGETHER TO COMPLETE THE TOP OF FRAME (SEE DIAGRAM #1 & #2)




STEP # 3 LIFT THE LEFT SIDE OF THE FRAME.
CONNECT B- PIPES TO ALL FITTINGS ALONG THE LENGTH
OF THE FRAME 7 PCS (SEE DIAGRAM #1)




STEP # 4 LIFT THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE FRAME. CONNECT B- PIPES TO ALL FITTINGS ALONG THE LENGTH OF THE FRAME 7 PCS




STEP # 5 ATTACH BATTING CAGE AND IMPACT NET TO THE FRAME. IMPACT NET IS PLACED INSIDE CAGE. ATTACH CAGE AND IMPACT NET TOGETHER USING SAME BUNGEE BALLS AND CORNER ROPES (SEE DIAGRAM # 3 AND ILLUSTRATION # 1).



STEP # 6 LIFT THE LEFT SIDE OF THE FRAME. CONNECT ALL B- PIPES TO ALL A- PIPES ON LEFT SIDE (SEE DIAGRAM # 2).



STEP #7 LIFT RIGHT SIDE OF FRAME. CONNECT A-PIPES TO B-PIPES







MAKE SURE PEOPLE STAY AT LEAST 3' AWAY FROM THE BATTING CAGE WHEN IN USE.
