Though the Dominican Republic is a small island, it is third in the world for sex tourism. Our organization is painfully aware of the significance if this darkness each and every day as we provide rescue, refuge, and restoration to young girls who have been impacted.

As noted by the U.S Department of State, in their 2020 Trafficking in Persons Report: "The Dominican Republic is a destination for sex tourist primarily from North America and Europe for child sex trafficking. Sex trafficking of 15-to-17-year-old girls occurs in streets, in parks, and on beaches."

SAFE HOMES

We have 3 residential homes now!

Each is a space for our girls to find refuge and healing. In our homes, we love them as we do our own daughters.





OUTREACH

We serve 200 girls every week.



1. Ministry of Light

We serve 200 girls and their families in our first donated little home "the mansion on the hill" in the barrio where it all began.

2. Casa Luz y Esperanza

In this home we walk with girls from the moment of rescue until they are ready to enter adulthood.

3. University House

This is our newest home, purchased in 2022. In it we serve girls who are preparing for adulthood and their university experiences.

4. Casa de Paz

This enchanced security home is for girls who have recieved their rescue and need additional levels of protection and care.
