CORRECT-ALL PRIMERTM is ideal for concrete, masonry, plaster, gypsum, metal or wood; and may be applied with brush, roller or spray. It dries in 30 minutes, presents and excellent hiding film that resist alkalinity, chipping and peeling, and enhances paint adhesion.

Surface Preparation

- 1. Remove all loose or peeling paint to provide a sound surface; Multi-coat peeling can be caused by adhesion failure in older paints
- 2. Wash; remove dirt and existing mildew, to prevent regrowth through the new paint film. Then rinse surfaces before priming or painting
- 3. Patch all holes and seal cracks

Product Applications

Stir thoroughly before using.

Paint always on shaded side of the building. Do not dilute paint, use as supplied. Do not apply when surface or air temperature is below 50°F or if rain is expected within 5 hours. Apply product generously with brush, roller or sprayer. Avoid excessive brushing or spreading too thinly. If you use a roller, we recommend a synthetic cover.

This product will perform as specified if the instructions on this label are followed for the preparation and application on surfaces.

Caution

Close the container tightly after using and KEEP AWAY FROM THE REACH OF CHILDREN. Refer to the SDS to obtain additional safety details before starting to use this product
