

# Instructions for Handwriting

### 1. USE THE CORRECT PEN.

To get the clearest and best reproduction of your handwriting onto your Your Script piece, it's really important to use a pen with a medium nib. Black ink is best.

#### 2. STAY WITHIN THE BOX

Write as largely as you can while staying within the writing box. If you write outside the outline of the box, your text will not appear correctly on your Your Script piece.

WILL NOT FIT CORRECTLY
ONTO YOUR PIECE



STAYING INSIDE THE BOX ENSURES YOUR TEXT APPEARS PERFECTLY ON YOUR PIECE.

#### 3. SPACING IS IMPORTANT

The way you write and space your text determines how the text looks on your finished piece.

4. WHAT YOU SEE IS WHAT YOU GET You will get exactly what you write. That includes symbols. You are only limited by your imagination. For example:


