INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

This switch panel is designed specifically for the 2011-2014 Ford Mustang GT. It is designed to mount inside the center console. There are no tools needed for the installation of this switch panel.

 Remove all items from the center console of the vehicle, and open the storage compartment. On the rear of the cup holders, gently pull up on the 2 tabs on the back of the rear cup holder. When you pull up, the console should come free from it's mounting tabs.



- 2. Once the console is loose, unplug the single electrical connector that connects to the hazard light/traction control buttons. Then, turn the console to the passenger side.
- 3. Now, reach inside the center console and push on the back of the accessory panel. When the panel pops loose, remove it from the console.
- 4. Pull your wires through the center console and wire the switch panel using the diagram provided. Wipe the area where the double sided tape will attach with alcohol wipes and peel the red backing off of the double sided tape. Place the panel in the cubby hole and firmly press the edges down.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

When wiring your switch panel, double check all of your wiring connections. For a clean, professional install we recommend using heat shrink of all crimped connectors. This will protect the connection, and make the connection stronger between the wire and crimp-on connector.
