

Installation Instructions for Front Skid Plate JP-5009, JP-5022, JP-5023, JP-5024, and JP-5025 for 2007-2018 Jeep® JK Wrangler

Thank you for purchasing your new Skid Row Offroad front skid plate. It is designed to give you peace of mind while traversing even the toughest trails.

Your skid plate package should come complete with the following parts:

- 1. (1) Front Skid Plate
- 2. (2) 3/8-16 x 1" Carriage Head Bolts
- 3. (2) 3/8-16 x 1" Hex Head Bolts
- 4. (4) 3/8-16 Hex Nuts

- 5. (2) 3/8 Small Flat Washers
- 6. (4) 3/8 Large Flat Washers
- 7. (4) 3/8 Lock Washers

Step 1: Remove the factory plastic front "skid plate".

washers are used under the nuts and lock washers.

Step 2: Lift the front skid plate into place and simply bolt it to the frame as shown in the photo below. Use the two hex head bolts at the top and the two carriage head bolts at the bottom of the skid plate. Place

Note: Not all of the holes at the bottom edge of the skid plate are used. The hole pattern on your front crossmember varies depending on the model year of your Jeep.

the 2 small flat washers under the heads of the hex bolts to prevent damage to the finish. The 4 large flat

Step 5: Tighten all four bolts and you're ready to hit the trail!
