While food labeling standards do not apply to coffee (the FDA does not consider coffee a food), we are happy to provide you with our ingredients!

Our ingredient is 100% CERTIFIED ORGANIC COFFEE for all of our non-flavored and decaf\* coffees

All of our coffees are CERTIFIED ORGANIC by Oregon Tilth and the USDA National Organic Program

We use only the highest quality, organic Arabica beans sourced from all over the world.

We estimate that we use among the world's highest 1% of quality Arabic beans!

We do not use Robusta Coffee, which is a lower grade.

Our Single Origin coffees are 100% from that origin, and each boasts unique flavor notes! Please visit JimsOrganicCoffee.com to learn more about these special regions, the organic coffee farmers we work with, as well as some of Jim's travels.

Due to confidentiality and seasonal changes, we do not list the origins that go into each of our Specialty Blends and Roasts. On occassion, we'll use coffees from different regions to reach our exact flavor notes.



## **OUR FLAVORED & DECAFS**

\*All of our coffees, with the exception of our Decafs and Flavored, are 100% CERTIFIED ORGANIC. Our Flavored and Decafs are Certified Organic through both Oregon Tilth and the USDA National Organic Program, but fall into their 95/5% Organic Rule.

Our Flavoreds are 97%+ Certified Organic Coffee and less than 3% all-natural flavoring, which has been certified for use in Certified Organic Coffee. Derived from plants, our natural flavors do not undergo a synthetic process. We do not manufacture the flavoring at our roasting facility and the ingredients are proprietary to our all-natural, organic-compliant supplier.

For our Decafs, we utilize the all-natural SwissWater® Process which is 100% chemical-free. They use a carbon filter to bind with - and extract - the caffeine molecules. The USDA had deemed that there is no such thing as organic carbon therefore our Decafs fall into the 95/5% rule. The SwissWater® decaffeination method is super cool.
