

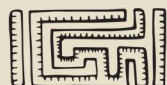

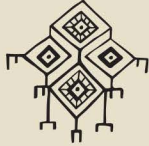


GUATEMALAN *Lake Atitlan Tzanchaj*

Biodiversity & Shade ...	Shade trees include cypress, pine, oak, chokecherry, banana, cedar, and citrus. Sighted birds include: toucan, goldfinch, eagle, hummingbird, horned guan, cardinal, budgie
Fun Facts	We built and stocked a library at the Tzanchaj school! With charity partner Child Aid, we support 2 schools in the area.
Harvest	Early Winter Harvest.

Biodiversity & Shade ... Shade trees include lamtoro, avocado, dadap, orange, clementine. This farm is Rainforest Alliance Certified.
Fun Facts Because of its depth, we use Indonesian in many blends.

Process Giling Basah: Naturally pulped. Dried on patios
Relationship Since 2010. Co-op has reformed but same coffee

Micro Region Southern Chiapas, near Tascana Volcano
Farmer(s) Schalit Family, Finca El Chorro
Biodiversity & Shade ... Over 200 shade species including teak, spanish cedar, oak, mahogany and zope (a rare hardwood). Smithsonian Bird Friendly Certified, with over 100 bird species
Fun Facts The farm is its own isolated biosphere; a unique example of coffee husbandry and forest preservation.
Harvest Early Winter Harvest
Altitude 700-1,000 Meters
Varietals Typica, Bourbon, Catui
