Chiapas Finca El Chorro is located on the high altitude slopes of the Sierra Madres, just north of the port city of Tapachula in southern Mexico. The combination of Pacific Ocean air currents, abundant plant life and heavy shade, and rich biodiversity make for ideal growing conditions for organic coffee.

With a focus on wildlife conservation and preserving a sustainable microclimate, Finca El Chorro has earned the Smithsonian Migratory Bird Friendly certification and is home to over 100 species of birds and 200 different plants.

Distinctive with its seductive aroma and gentle mellow taste, this coffee is quite versatile, used in many of our coffee blends to add a subtle milk-chocolate taste and silky depth.

About Finca El Chorro

Finca El Chorro is located near the Tascana Volcano in Chiapas, a southern Mexican state bordering Guatemala. Sprawling across the fertile ridges of the Sierra Madre de Chiapas, El Chorro covers 730 acres of land, with 90% dedicated to shade grown coffee production and 10% to wildlife preservation.

Certified as Bird Friendly by the Smithsonian Migratory Bird Center, this “agroforest” is home to a multitude of bird varieties, including blue magpies, parrots, and the resplendent quetzal. The farmland is shaded by Teak, Spanish Cedar, Oak, and Mahogany hardwood trees, as well as the Zope Tree, a precious old hardwood of the region. The abundance of foliage, accompanied by sustainable farming practices, create a richly diverse microclimate, welcoming many species of birds and insects and promoting excellent soil and growing conditions for organic coffee.

Finca El Chorro earned its OCIA Organic Certification in 1999 under the care of its current owners, the Schalit family. Jim’s Organic Coffee has been a proud supporter of El Chorro for over a decade, and Jim has made various trips to the farm, always admiring their hospitality, biodiversity, and quality and conservation efforts.
