

How to Decide on Keywords for a Research Paper

1. **Brainstorm and list ideas**

To find relevant research keywords brainstorm ideas and list them. Do not worry about narrowing the keywords yet because there is plenty of time for you to do that. In this step, you just list everything that comes to your mind. Focus on listing strong nouns and verbs which are quite frequently used in research papers. When you have a long list of keywords, determine which are relevant to your research by keeping your research idea in mind and by eliminating keywords that seem too irrelevant.

1. **Scan the research question and thesis**

Research question and thesis of the research paper are the whole crux of research paper on which your whole essay revolves around. An efficient way to identify keywords is to analyze your research question and thesis statement when [write my paper](#). As these two determine what the research is going to be about, you will be able to create several keywords from your research question and thesis statement. Keywords should be indicative of what the research is going to be about. So your key concepts used in the research question and thesis statement will help find keywords that are closely related to your topic.

1. **Background research is also helpful in determining keywords**

Doing background research on your topic also helps to find relevant keywords. When you are researching a topic, you do background research to identify important facts about the topic. You do that by searching on the internet, research catalogs, encyclopedias, and books. Doing the preliminary background research will help you to identify and narrow down your research keywords.

1. **Bibliographies at the end of research papers**

Bibliographies at the end of research papers contain information about articles that are cited in that paper. Search for research papers that are relevant to your own topic and take a look at the bibliography. Each reference in the bibliography contains complete information about the cited article. 1. **Take a look at keywords from similar research papers**

As these papers are relevant to your topic, these keywords will help you to determine the keywords of your research paper. 1. **Find synonyms**

1. **Make a keywords chart**

A keyword chart lists all those concepts that are relevant to your topics and help you to narrow your terms. A typical keyword chart contains keywords, topics, similar terms, broader terms, narrower terms, and related terms. Keyword charts are especially helpful to find keywords that precisely define your research paper. Keyword charts also help to refine your keyword choices.

1. **Use a keyword generator tool**
