

Halloween Log Cabin

20 1/2" x 52 1/2"

Abbreviations used throughout this pattern:

RST: Right Sides Together WOF: Width of Fabric

Please read through the entire pattern before starting.

Note: The border measurements below are mathematically accurate. However, you should measure your quilt and mark and/or cut your borders to your length to ensure that your quilt is not wavy.

Cutting instructions:

Fabric / Requirements	First Cut	Second Cut (Label)
Black – 1 yard including Applique shapes	1 – 1 1/2 x WOF Strip 4 – 3 x WOF Strip for borders 4 – 2 1/2 x WOF Strip for binding	12 – 1 1/2 x 1 1/2 squares (1)
Orange – 1/4 yard	2 – 1 1/2 x WOF Strip	12 – 1 1/2 x 2 1/2 rectangles (4) 12 – 1 1/2 x 3 1/2 rectangles (5)
Green – 1/4 yard	4 – 1 1/2 x WOF Strips	12 – 1 1/2 x 4 1/2 rectangles (8) 12 – 1 1/2 x 5 1/2 rectangles (9)
Purple – 1/4 yard	5 – 1 1/2 x WOF Strip	12 – 1 1/2 x 6 1/2 rectangles (12) 12 – 1 1/2 x 7 1/2 rectangles (13)
White background – 3/4 yard	1 – 8 1/2 x WOF Strip Trim remainder of WOF to 7 1/2 1 – 6 1/2 x WOF Strip Trim remainder of WOF to 5 1/2 1 – 4 1/2 x WOF Strip Trim remainder of WOF to 3 1/2 1 – 2 1/2 x WOF Strip Trim remainder of WOF to 1 1/2	12 – 1 1/2 x 8 1/2 rectangles (15) 12 – 1 1/2 x 7 1/2 rectangles (14) 12 – 1 1/2 x 6 1/2 rectangles (11) 12 – 1 1/2 x 5 1/2 rectangles (10) 12 – 1 1/2 x 4 1/2 rectangles (7) 12 – 1 1/2 x 3 1/2 rectangles (6) 12 – 1 1/2 x 2 1/2 rectangles (3) 12 – 1 1/2 squares (2)

All seams are 1/4".

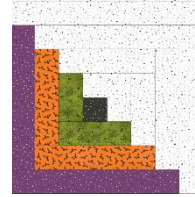
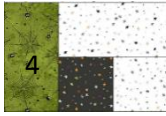
- 1) Stitch #1 square to #2 square.



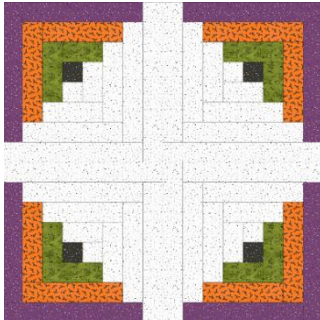
- 2) Stitch #3 to the top of previous unit.



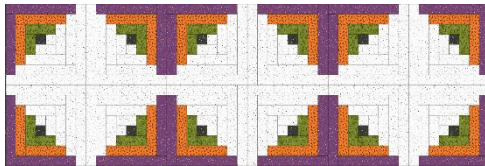
- 3) Working counterclockwise, continue adding strips in numerical order through strip #15 to complete one quadrant. Unit should measure 8 1/2".



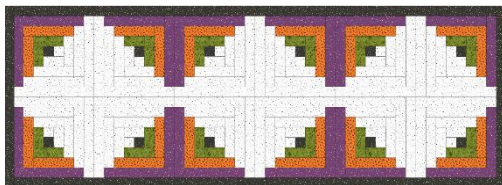
- 4) Repeat for a total of 12 blocks.
- 5) Assemble four quadrants as shown. Block should measure 16 1/2".



- 6) Repeat to make 3 blocks.
- 7) Using your preferred applique method, applique design to center of block.
- 8) Sew 3 blocks together in a row. Sides should measure 16 1/2". Top and bottom should measure 52 1/2".



- 9) Measure the sides of the quilt top. Cut your borders to this length and sew to sides. Measure the top and bottom. Piece the 3" strips and cut to this measurement. Sew the top and bottom borders on and press towards the border.



- 10) Quilt as desired.
- 11) Bind runner.
