
## SPRING CHICKEN BASKET

Finished side 4" diameter x 3 $1/4$ " (6" with handle)
INSTRUCTIONS
<ol> <li>Sides - Cut one piece fabric 3 1/2" x 13 1/4"</li> <li>Bottom - Cut one circle (4 1/2" diameter)</li> <li>Lay each piece over cotton batting that is slightly larger.</li> <li>Machine stitch close to the edges of the fabric.</li> <li>Trim away excess batting.</li> <li>With right sides together, sew the 3 1/2" sides together to form a cylinder.</li> <li>With right sides together sew the cylinder to the circle bottom (It is easier to while sewing.)</li> <li>Turn right side out.</li> </ol>
<ol> <li>Sides - Cut one piece x 5 1/2" x 13 1/4"</li> <li>Bottom - Cut one circle (4 1/2" diameter)</li> <li>With right sides together, sew the 5 1/2" ends together to form a cylinder.</li> <li>With right sides together sew the cylinder to the circle bottom.</li> </ol>

- 5. Do not turn right side out.
- 6. Turn under the top edge 1/4", press and turn under another 1/4" and press and machine stitch the hem.
- 7. Place the lining in the outside with wrong sides together.
- 8. Fold the lining over the outside about 1" and press.
- 9. Machine topstitch 1/4'' from the top edge.

## Handles

- 1. Cut one piece 3" x 9"
- 2. Turn under 1/4" on each end and press.
- 3. Fold the sides to the center and press.
- 4. Fold again so that the folded edges meet and topstitch close to the edges.
- 5. Place the ends of the handle to the inside of the basket and sew buttons on
- the outside sewing through the buttons and the ends of the handles to secure the handles.
