

“Cookies from Home”...Cookie Tray

* Fabric Requirements

1 Cookies from Home panel
½ yard dot background for tray center
¼ yard light print for prairie points
¼ yard medium print for prairie points
⅝ yard stripe for border
¾ yard for backing

Yardage is based on 42 - inch wide fabric

* Cutting Instructions

Cookie Tray

From Cookies from Home panel:
**Tray outline shape on panel is to be used as cookie tray template...use care when cutting out cookie shapes and frostings!*

- Cut 9 large cookie shapes
- Cut 9 medium frosting shapes
- Cut 9 small frosting shapes

From dot for tray center:

- Cut 1, 16 ½ x 27 ½ - inch rectangle

Prairie Points

From each print:

- Cut 2, 3 ½ x 42 - inch strips
- From these strips
Cut 17, 3 ½ x 3 ½ - inch squares

Border:

From stripe:

- Cut 2, 6 x 42 - inch strips
- Cut 1, 7 ¾ x 42 - inch strip
- From this strip
Cut 2, 7 ¾ x 16 ½ - inch rectangles

* Piecing

Use ¼ - inch seam allowance throughout

- Arrange cookies, medium frostings, and small frosting shapes into nine different groupings.
- Arrange groupings onto the 16 ½ x 27 ½ - inch dot tray center.
- Starting with bottom layer sew each shape to tray center stitching up to ¼ - inch in from edge.

Prairie Points

- Fold 3 ½ - inch squares in half twice diagonally and press.

Border

- With right sides facing, layer 6 prairie points between tray center and each short border...attach.
- With right sides facing, layer 11 prairie points between tray center and each long border...attach.
- Press prairie points towards borders.

* Finishing

- Layer, baste, hand or machine quilt.
- Center cookie tray template onto quilt. Trace shape and cut.
- Stitch ¼ - inch in from raw edge around entire tray shape including handle cutouts.

Fray edge

- Clip all raw edges at ¼ - inch intervals being careful not to clip stitch lines.
- Wash and dry to create fray look.

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Embellish cookies with lots of buttons, beads, sequins and threads!
