Fabric Requirements

1 Clementine panel (#22100-11)

¼ yard **each** blue, purple, pink and orange swirl for pinwheels (#22045-33, #22045-34, #22045-31, #22045-32)

¼ yard **each** blue, purple, pink and orange dot for pinwheels (#22106-13, #22106-14, #22106-11, # 22106-12)

⅓ yard green print for first border (22105-15)

¾ yard purple print for second border (22103-14)

½ yard purple swirl for binding (#22045-34)

3¼ yards purple print for backing (#22101-14)

Yardage is based on 40 - inch wide fabric.

Cutting Instructions

Blocks

From Clementine panel:

- Trim 8 blocks to measure 9 x 9 - inches square

From **each** swirl for pinwheels:

- Cut 1, 5½ x 40 - inch strip
From this strip cut
4, 5½ - inch squares

From **each** dot for pinwheels:

- Cut 1, 5½ x 40 - inch strip
From this strip cut
4, 5½ - inch squares

Borders

From green print for first border:

- Cut 4, 2 x 40 - inch strips
From these strips cut
2, 2 x 34½ - inch strips
2, 2 x 37½ - inch strips

From purple print for second border:

- Cut 5, 4¼ x 40 - inch strips

Binding

From purple swirl for binding:

- Cut 6, 2¼ x 40 - inch strips

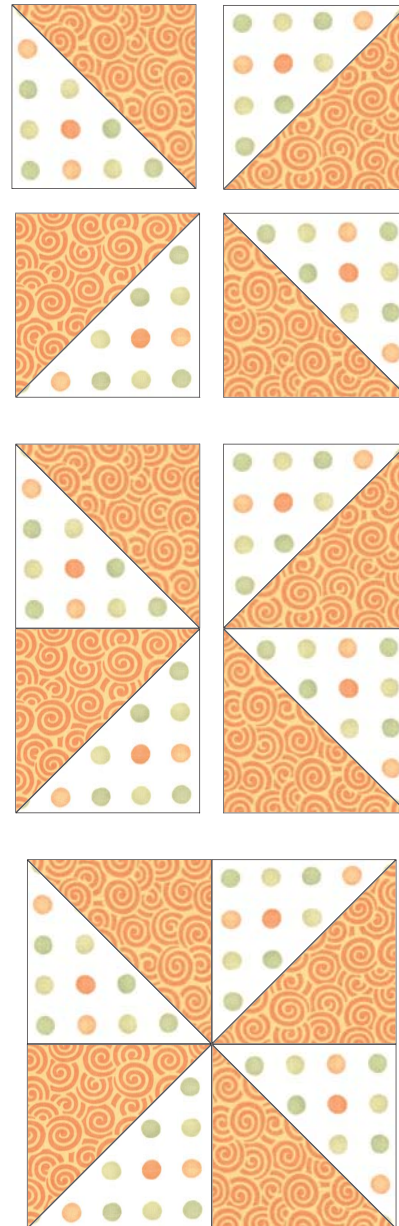
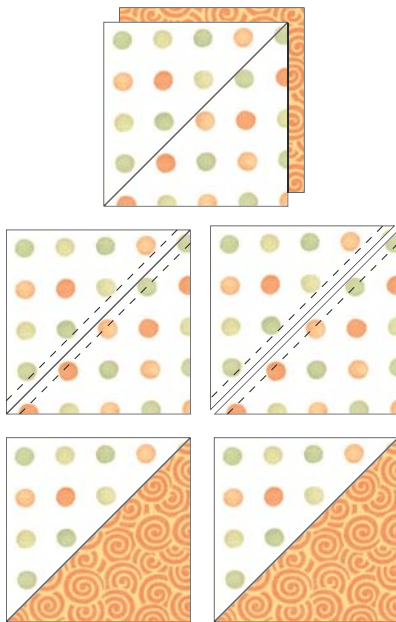


Piecing

Use $\frac{1}{4}$ - inch seam allowance throughout, a small stitch length, and press seams open.

Blocks

- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each orange dot $5\frac{1}{2}$ - inch square.
- With right sides facing, layer one orange dot and one orange swirl $5\frac{1}{2}$ - inch square together. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ - inch away from each side of drawn line. Cut apart on marked line and press. Trim half square triangles to measure $4\frac{3}{4}$ - inches square. Make 8 orange half square triangles.



- Make 8 half square triangle from each remaining color group...purple dots with purple swirls, pink dots with pink swirls and blue dots with blue swirls.
 - Make 2 blue, 2 purple, 2 pink and 2 orange pinwheel blocks.
- Keeping like colors together, sew 4 half square triangles together as shown to make pinwheels. Pinwheels should measure 9 x 9 - inches.



Quilt Assembly

- Referring to the quilt diagram, arrange and sew 4 rows of 4 blocks each. Sew rows together.

Quilt should now measure
34½ x 34½ inches.

Borders

First Border:

- Arrange and sew a 2 x 34½ - inch green print first border strip to each side of the quilt center and sew a 2 x 37½ - inch green print strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center.

Quilt should now measure
37½ x 37½ - inches square.

Second Border:

- Piece 5, 4¼ x 40 - inch purple second border strips end to end.
- Measure the quilt from top to bottom through the middle to determine the length of side borders.
- From pieced length cut side borders to the needed length and attach to the quilt.
- Measure the quilt from side to side through the middle including side borders to determine the length of top and bottom borders.
- From pieced length cut top and bottom borders to the needed length and attach to the quilt.

Finishing

- Layer, baste, hand or machine quilt, trim, and add binding.
