## Fabric Requirements

1 Clementine panel (\#22100-11)
$1 / 4$ yard each blue, purple, pink and orange swirl for pinwheels (\#22045-33, \#22045-34, \#22045-31, \#22045-32)
$1 / 4$ yard each blue, purple, pink and orange dot for pinwheels (\#22106-13, \#22106-14, \#22106-11, \# 22106-12)
$1 / 3$ yard green print for first border (22105-15)
$3 / 4$ yard purple print for second border (22103-14)
$1 / 2$ yard purple swirl for binding (\#22045-34)
31/4 yards purple print for backing (\#22101-14)
Yardage is based on 40 - inch wide fabric.

## Cutting Instructions

## Blocks

From Clementine panel:

- Trim 8 blocks to measure $9 \times 9$ - inches square

From each swirl for pinwheels:

- Cut $1,5^{1 ⁄ 2} \times 40$ - inch strip

From this strip cut
$4,51 / 2$ - inch squares


From each dot for pinwheels:

- Cut $1,5^{1 ⁄ 2} \times 40$ - inch strip From this strip cut $4,5^{1 / 2}$ - inch squares


## Borders

From green print for first border:

- Cut 4, $2 \times 40$ - inch strips

From these strips cut
2, $2 \times 34112$ - inch strips
$2,2 \times 371 / 2$ - inch strips
From purple print for second border:

- Cut 5, $4^{1 / 4} \times 40$ - inch strips


## Binding

From purple swirl for binding:

- Cut $6,2^{114} \times 40$ - inch strips


## Piecing

Use $1 / 4$ - inch seam allowance throughout, a small stitch length, and press seams open.

## Blocks

- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each orange dot $51 / 2$ - inch square.
- With right sides facing, layer one orange dot and one orange swirl $51 / 2$ - inch square together. Stitch $1 / 4$ - inch away from each side of drawn line. Cut apart on marked line and press. Trim half square triangles to measure $43 / 4$ - inches square. Make 8 orange half square triangles.

- Make 8 half square triangle from each remaining color group...purple dots with purple swirls, pink dots with pink swirls and blue dots with blue swirls.
- Keeping like colors together, sew 4 half square triangles together as shown to make pinwheels. Pinwheels should measure $9 \times 9$ - inches.
- Make 2 blue, 2 purple, 2 pink and 2 orange pinwheel blocks.


## Quilt Assembly

- Referring to the quilt diagram, arrange and sew 4 rows of 4 blocks each. Sew rows together.
Quilt should now measure $34112 \times 341 / 2$ inches.


## Borders

## First Border:

- Arrange and sew a $2 \times 341 / 2$ - inch green print first border strip to each side of the quilt center and sew a $2 \times 371 / 2$ - inch green print strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center.
Quilt should now measure $371 / 2 \times 371 / 2$ - inches square.


## Second Border:

- Piece 5, $41 / 4 \times 40$ - inch purple second border strips end to end.
- Measure the quilt from top to bottom through the middle to determine the length of side borders.
- From pieced length cut side borders to the needed length and attach to the quilt.
- Measure the quilt from side to side through the middle including side borders to determine the length of top and bottom borders.
- From pieced length cut top and bottom borders to the needed length and attach to the quilt.


## Finishing

- Layer, baste, hand or machine quilt, trim,
