



# Hi De Ho Cheerio!

a free pattern from  
**Me and My Sister Designs**

Made with “Hi-De-Ho” fabric for Moda

28½ x 28½ - inches

## Fabric Requirements

8, 10 x 10 - inch print squares for blocks  
1½ yard white for blocks, block sashing and border  
½ yard turquoise print for binding  
1 yard of fabric for backing

Yardage is based on 40 - inch wide fabric.

## Cutting Instructions

### Blocks

From each 10 x 10 - inch print square for blocks:

- Cut 2, 2⅞ x 2⅞ - inch squares  
4, 2½ x 2½ - inch squares  
Keep like prints together.

From white for blocks:

- Cut 2, 2⅞ x 40 - inch strips  
From these strips cut  
16, 2⅞ x 2⅞ - inch squares
- Cut 1, 2½ x 40 - inch strip  
From this strip cut  
8, 2½ x 2½ - inch squares

### Block Sashing

From white for block sashing:

- Cut 2, 1½ x 40 - inch strips  
From these strips cut  
4, 1½ x 6½ - inch rectangles  
4, 1½ x 7½ - inch rectangles

- Cut 3, 3½ x 40 - inch strips  
From these strips cut  
4, 3½ x 7½ - inch rectangles  
4, 3½ x 10½ - inch rectangles
- Cut 1, 6½ x 40 - inch strip  
From this strip cut  
2, 6½ x 4½ - inch rectangles  
1, 6½ x 14½ - inch rectangle

### Border

From white for border:

- Cut 4, 1½ x 40 - inch strips  
From these strips cut  
2, 1½ x 26½ - inch side borders  
2, 1½ x 28½ - inch top and bottom borders

### Binding

From turquoise print for binding:

- Cut 4, 2¼ x 40 - inch strips

## Piecing

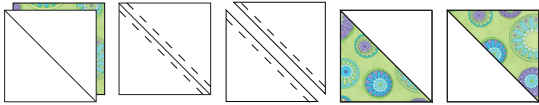
Use ¼ - inch seam allowance throughout, a small stitch length, and press seams open.

### Blocks

- For each Cheerio block you will need:  
2, 2⅞ x 2⅞ - inch print squares  
4, 2½ x 2½ - inch matching print squares  
2, 2⅞ x 2⅞ - inch white squares  
1, 2½ x 2½ - inch white square

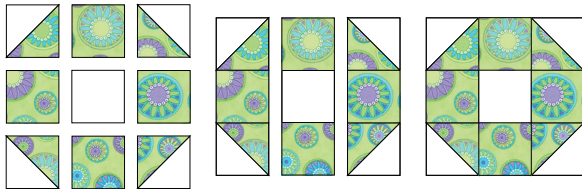


- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 2,  $2\frac{7}{8} \times 2\frac{7}{8}$  - inch white squares. With right sides facing, layer 1,  $2\frac{7}{8} \times 2\frac{7}{8}$  - inch white square and 1,  $2\frac{7}{8} \times 2\frac{7}{8}$  - inch print square together. Stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$  - inch away from each side of the drawn line. Cut apart on marked line and press. Half square triangles measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$  - inches square.



Make 4 half square triangles.

- Arrange and sew: 4 half square triangles, 4,  $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$  - inch matching print squares and 1,  $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$  - inch white square into a block as shown.



Block measures  $6\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$  - inches.

- Repeat with the remaining prints for a total of 8 blocks.

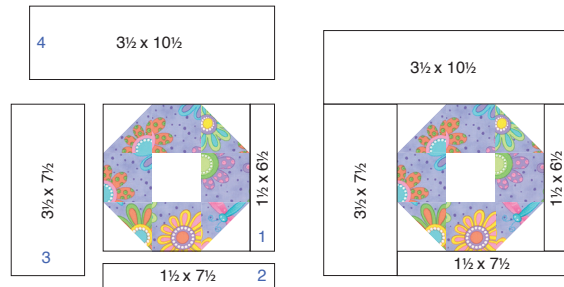
### Block Sashing

There are two different block sashing combinations.

For the first you will need:

- 1 Cheerio block
- 1,  $1\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$  - inch white rectangle
- 1,  $1\frac{1}{2} \times 7\frac{1}{2}$  - inch white rectangle
- 1,  $3\frac{1}{2} \times 7\frac{1}{2}$  - inch white rectangle
- 1,  $3\frac{1}{2} \times 10\frac{1}{2}$  - inch white rectangle

- Arrange and sew rectangles as shown working clockwise.

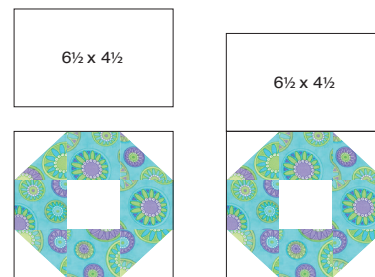


Make 4

For the second you will need:

- 1 Cheerio block
- 1,  $4\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$  - inch white rectangle

- Arrange and sew as shown.

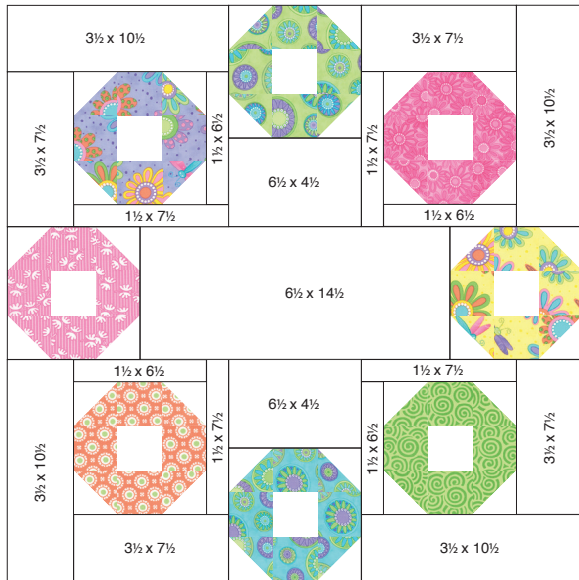


Make 2

### Quilt Assembly

- Arrange, rotate and sew: 6 Cheerio blocks with sashing, 2 Cheerio blocks and 1,  $6\frac{1}{2} \times 14\frac{1}{2}$  - inch white rectangle into the quilt center as shown.





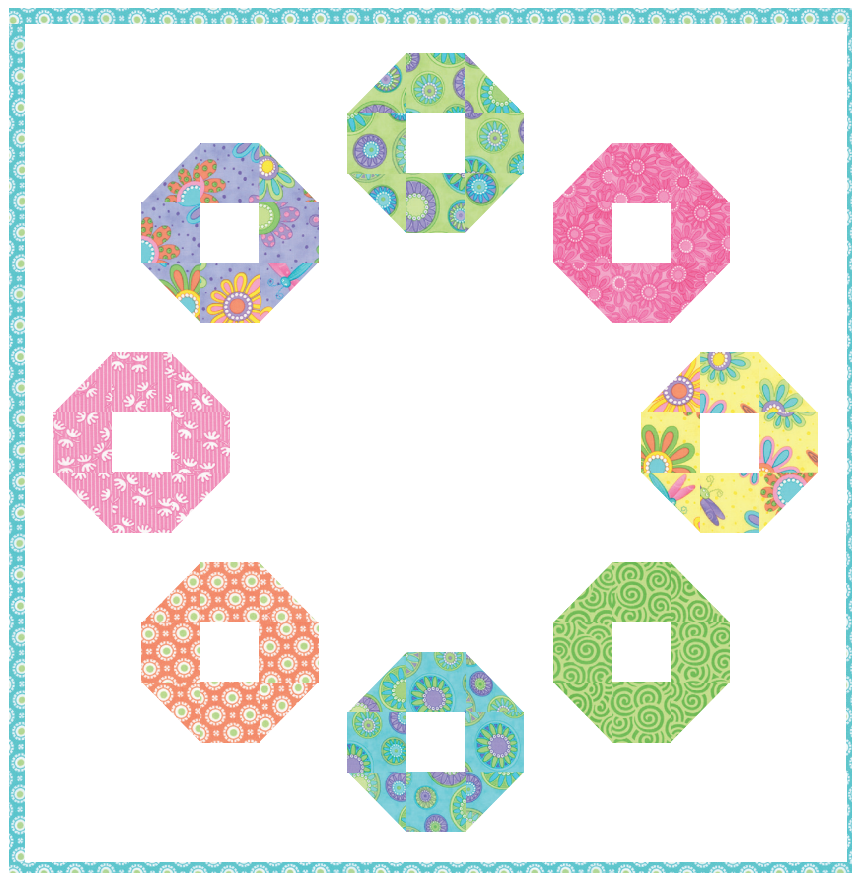
Quilt center measures 26½ x 26½ - inches.

### Border

- Sew a 1½ x 26½ - inch white side border to each side of the quilt center. Then sew a 1½ x 28½ - inch white border to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Quilt measures 28½ x 28½ - inches.

### Finishing

- Layer, baste, hand or machine quilt, trim, and add binding.
