11 coordinating 6 - inch hexagons
22087-35, 22212-14, 22212-16, 22214-14,
22214-16, 22215-14, 22215-16, 22216-14,
22216-16, 22216-25 and 22217-16
$3 / 4$ yard white for quilt center
$1 / 4$ yard print 1 for bold stripe 22211-14
$1 / 4$ yard print 2 for bold stripe 22213-14
$1 / 4$ yard print 3 for bold stripe 22216-15
$3 / 8$ yard print for binding 22215-14
$13 / 8$ yards of fabric for backing 22214-28

Yardage is based on 40 - inch wide fabric.

* Cutting Instructions


## Quilt Center

From white for quilt center:

- Cut $1,211 / 2 \times 321 / 2$ - inch rectangle
- Cut $1,31 / 2 \times 321 / 2$ - inch strip

From each of the 3 prints for quilt center:

- Cut $1,61 / 2 \times 32 \frac{1}{2}$ - inch print 1 strip Cut $1,61 / 2 \times 321 / 2$ - inch print 2 strip Cut $1,61 / 2 \times 321 / 2$ - inch print 3 strip


## Binding

From print for binding:

- Cut $5,2 \frac{1}{4} \times 40$ - inch strips


## *้ใuilt Assembly

Use $1 / 4$ - inch seam allowance throughout, a small stitch length, and press seams open.
$32^{1} 12 \times 42^{1} 1 / 2$ - inches

- Referring to the quilt diagram, arrange and sew:
$1,211 / 2 \times 321 / 2$ - inch white rectangle
$1,31 / 2 \times 321 / 2$ - inch white strip and
$3,61 / 2 \times 321 / 2$ - inch print strips
to make the quilt top.


## Hexagons

- Arrange the 11 hexagons onto the quilt as shown in the quilt diagram. Use your favorite method of applique to sew the hexagons onto the quilt.


## Finishing

- Layer, baste, hand or machine quilt, trim, and add binding.
