# Ready Set Snow TableRunner

17½ x 42½ inches

## Fabric Requirements...

¾ yard red dot for table runner center and binding

¼ yard green swirl for table runner center

½ yard red snowflake for first border

⅓ yard red swirl for second border

1⅜ yards green dot for backing

*Yardage is based on 40 - inch wide fabric.*

## Cutting Instructions...

From red dot for table runner center:

Cut 1, 1½ x 30½ - inch strip

From green swirl for table runner center:

Cut 2, 2½ x 30½ - inch strips

From red snowflake for first border:

Cut 3, 4½ x 40 - inch strips

From these strips cut

2, 4½ x 38½ - inch strips

2, 4½ x 5½ - inch rectangles

From red swirl for second border:

Cut 3, 2½ x 40 - inch strips

From these strips cut

2, 2½ x 38½ - inch strips

2, 2½ x 17½ - inch rectangles

From red dot for binding:

Cut 4, 2¼ x 40 - inch strips

## Table Runner Assembly...

*Use ¼ - inch seam allowance throughout, a small stitch length, and press seams open.*

- Arrange and sew a 2½ x 30½ - inch green swirl center strip to each side of the 1½ x 30½ - inch red dot center strip as shown.



- Arrange and sew a 4½ x 5½ - inch red snowflake first border rectangle to each end of the table runner center as shown.



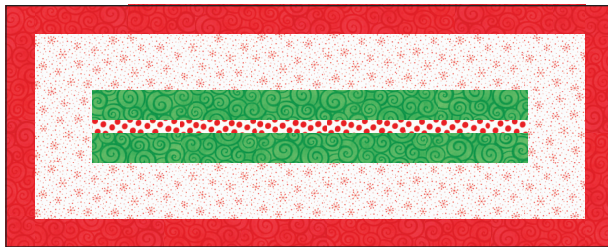
- Arrange and sew a 4½ x 38½ - inch red snowflake first border strip to each side of the table runner center as shown.



- Arrange and sew a 2½ x 38½ - inch red-swirl second border strip to each side of the table runner center as shown.



- Arrange and sew a 2½ x 17½ - inch red swirl second border strip to each end of the table runner center as shown.



### Finishing...

- Layer, baste, hand or machine quilt, trim and add binding.
