## \%\%Fabric \& Supplies

$1 / 4$ yard pink floral flannel for sashing \#22192-21F
$1 / 4$ yard turquoise floral flannel for sashing \#22192-15F
$1 / 4$ yard white floral flannel for sashing \#22192-11F
$3 / 4$ yard pink leaves flannel for blocks \#22193-11F
$3 / 4$ yard pink dots flannel for blocks \#22195-21F
$3 / 4$ yard turquoise leaves flannel for blocks \#22193-15F
$3 / 4$ yard turquoise dots flannel for blocks \#22195-25F
$3 / 4$ yard blue leaves flannel for blocks \#22193-12F
$3 / 4$ yard blue dots flannel for blocks \#22195-22F
$11 / 2$ yards ( 40 - inch wide) cotton batting Yardage is based on 40 - inch wide fabric.

## Cutting Instructions

## Sashing

From each pink, turquoise and white floral:

- Cut $2,4 \times 40$ - inch strips


## Blocks

From each pink, turquoise and blue leaves:

- Cut $3,71 / 2 \times 40$ - inch strips

From these strips cut
$12,71 / 2 \times 71 / 2$ - inch squares
$40 \times 49$ - inches
From each pink, turquoise and blue dots:

- Cut 3, 7½ $\times 40$ - inch strips

From these strips cut
$12,71 / 2 \times 71 / 2$ - inch squares

From cotton batting for blocks and sashing:

- Cut 3, $3 \times 39$ - inch strips
- Cut 6, 6½ $\times 40$ - inch strips

From these strips cut
$36,61 / 2 \times 61 / 2$ - inch squares

## apiecing

## Blocks

- With wrong sides facing, layer two matching $71 / 2 \times 71 / 2$ - inch pink leaves squares together. Right sides will be facing out.
- Place a $61 / 2 \times 61 / 2$ - inch square of batting between these two squares and pin in place.
- Machine stitch around the flannel/batting sandwich 1 -inch from the edges on all 4 sides as shown.

- Make 6 each: pink, turquoise and blue leaf blocks.
- Make 6 each: pink, turquoise and blue dot blocks.

You will have a total of 36 blocks.


## Sashing

- With wrong sides facing, layer two matching $4 \times 40$ - inch pink floral strips together. Right sides will be facing out.
- Place a $3 \times 39$ - inch strip of batting between these two strips and pin in place.
- Machine stitch around the flannel/batting sandwich 1 -inch from the edges on all 4 sides as shown.

- Make 1 each: pink, turquoise and white floral sashing rectangles for a total of 3 .


## \&uilt Assembly

- Using a $1 / 2$ inch seam allowance, sew the sides of two blocks together as shown. The seam will be facing the front of the quilt.

- Alternate the blocks, sew 3 pink dot blocks and 3 pink leaf blocks into rows as shown.


Make 1 of each

- Make the same 2 rows with the turquoise and blue blocks.
- Using a $1 / 2$-inch seam allowance, refer to the quilt diagram and sew the sashing rectangles between the rows as shown. All seams will be facing the front of the quilt.


## *Finishing

- To finish quilt, stitch $1 / 2$ - inch from outer edges around all 4 sides.
- Using a sharp pair of scissors, clip all seams and edges at $1 / 4$ - intervals. Make sure to get close, but do not clip through the seam lines.
- Wash and dry your quilt on a hot setting to fray the seam allowances and edges. Check the lint filter often to remove excess lint. We recommend washing your quilt the first time at a commercial laundry.
