CTF 101 Elementary Thai Language (72 hours)

CTF 101 Beginning Thai

Prerequisite: None

Course description

Study Thai vocabulary related to daily life. So that learners can use vocabulary in everyday conversations, including food, beverages, vegetables, fruits, numbers, prices and counting. various kinds of animals, essential supplies classification of sizes and types of objects, important places, greetings, asking questions, and answering questions on matters necessary for the lives of foreigners.

CTF 102 Elementary Thai Language for Skills (72 hours)

CTF 102 Beginning Thai Plus

Prerequisite: CTF 101 : Elementary Thai Language

Course description

Study consonants, vowels and word combinations, practice pronunciation, writing words from pictures, practice writing reading words or writing Thai sentences from pictures, practice reading words and short sentences. Study writing, read numbers, practice writing sentences from pictures. Practice writing question sentences from the given vocabulary.

CTF 103 Intermediate Thai Language (72 hours)

CTF 103 Intermediate Thai

Prerequisite: CTF 102 : Elementary Thai Language for Skills Enhancement

Course description

Study about learning the names of important places and various tourist attractions forming questions about places. Writing question sentences. Practice writing sentences from the pictures of the given places. Practice making a sentences and telling stories from pictures. Study about direction and symbols of traffic routes. Study about the map of

Thailand and the regional divisions of Thailand. Learn about the seasons of Thailand.

Creating a telling sentence from a given picture.

CTF 104 Intermediate Thai for Skills (72 hours)

CTF 104 Intermediate Thai Plus

Prerequisite: CTF 103 : Intermediate Thai Language

Course description

Study family vocabulary, question sentence construction or descriptive sentences about family. Study short stories about family characteristics. Learn about the month of Thai language in reading, writing and speaking. Practice writing a resume and introducing yourself to other people and referring friends or acquaintances to other people. Study the way of life and play of Thai society.

CTF 105 Basic Thai Reading and Writing Level 1 (72 hours)

CTF 105 Basic Thai – Reading and Writing 1

Prerequisite : CTF 104 : Intermediate Thai Language for Fundamentals

Course description

Study Thai alphabet, how to write Thai characters, the structure of the Thai alphabet consists of middle, high, low characters. Study Thai vowels and how to write Thai vowels. Study of vowel shapes in Thai, study of spelling and tone, practice writing compounds of Thai letters and vowels. Practice writing words from pictures. Practice composing sentences from the given words. Practice separating consonants, vowels, spellings, and tones from words.

CTF 106 Basic Thai Reading and Writing Level 2 (72 hours)

CTF 106 Basic Thai – Reading and Writing 2

Prerequisite : CTF 105 : Basic Thai Reading and Writing Level 1

Course description

Study the real diphthongs and the inaccurate diphthongs. Practice making sentences from diphthongs. Study introductory letters and word combinations of various types of introductory letters, practice composing sentences from the prescriptive letters. Learn how to use the short vowel marker of Thai writing system represented by “๘” and use of the repeat symbol of Thai writing system represented by “๑”. How to use the mark placed over the final consonant of a word in Thai language to indicate that it is mute. How to use vowels “ue” with spelling and without letter after. How to use the vowel “ah”, when the spell is turned into a vowel symbol of Thai writing system. Study homophones study homophones.

CTF 107 Thai Short Stories 1 (108 hours)

CTF 107 Thai Short Stories 1

Prerequisite: CTF 106 : Basic Level 2 Thai Reading and Writing

Course description

Study and learn vocabulary from short stories by reading, short stories about daily life family, short stories tourist attraction and other short stories with simple words and practice answering questions from each short story that is read and understood.

CTF 108 Thai Short Stories 2 (108 hours)

CTF 108 Thai Short Stories 2

Prerequisite: CTF 107 : Thai Short Story 1

Course description

Study stories from short stories with high content and vocabulary. Practice summarizing key points and explain the story from the short story. Practice asking questions from short stories. Learn Thai conversation and practice conversation in different situations.
