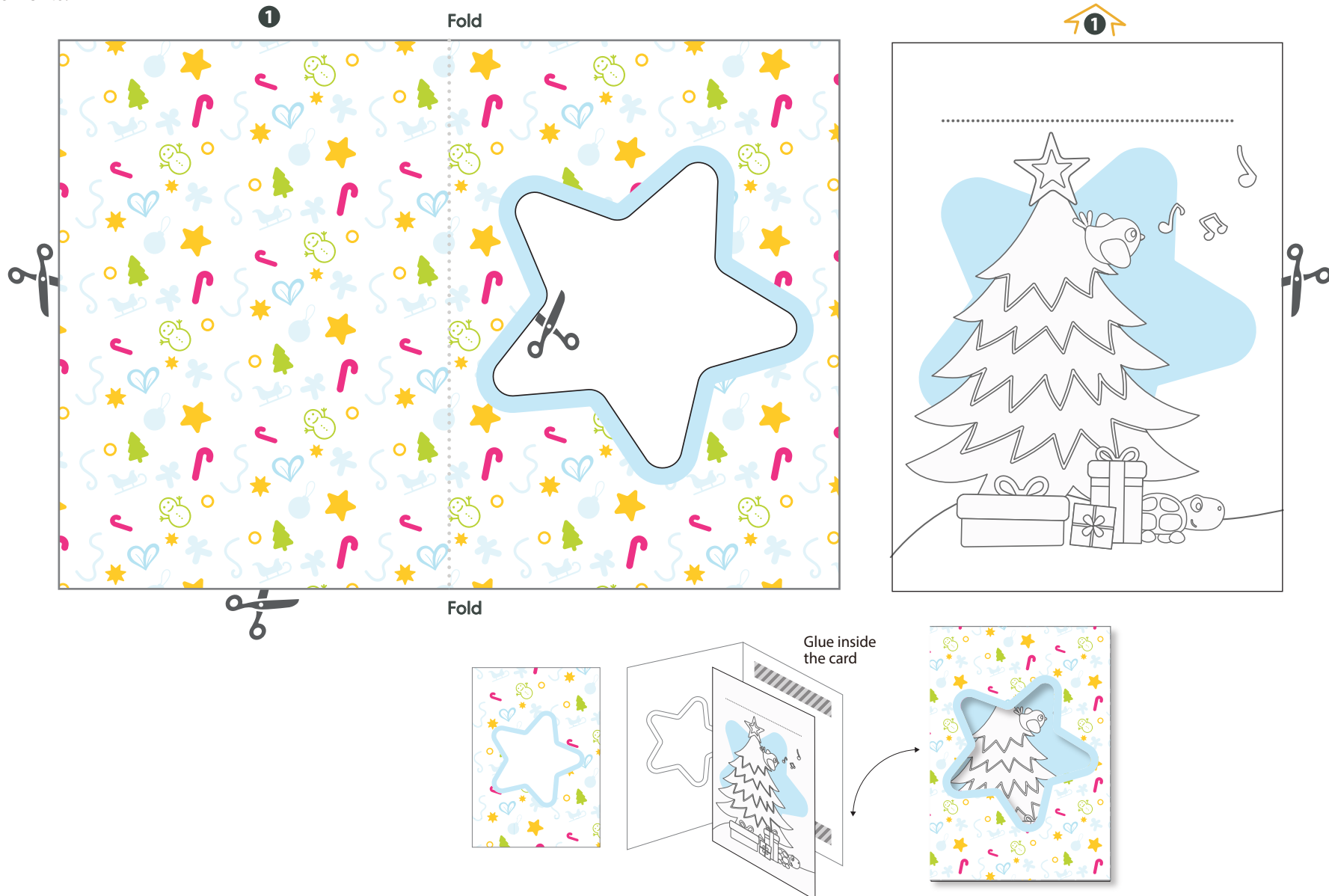

Tip: Customise the Christmas tree by drawing on your own decorations and ornaments!

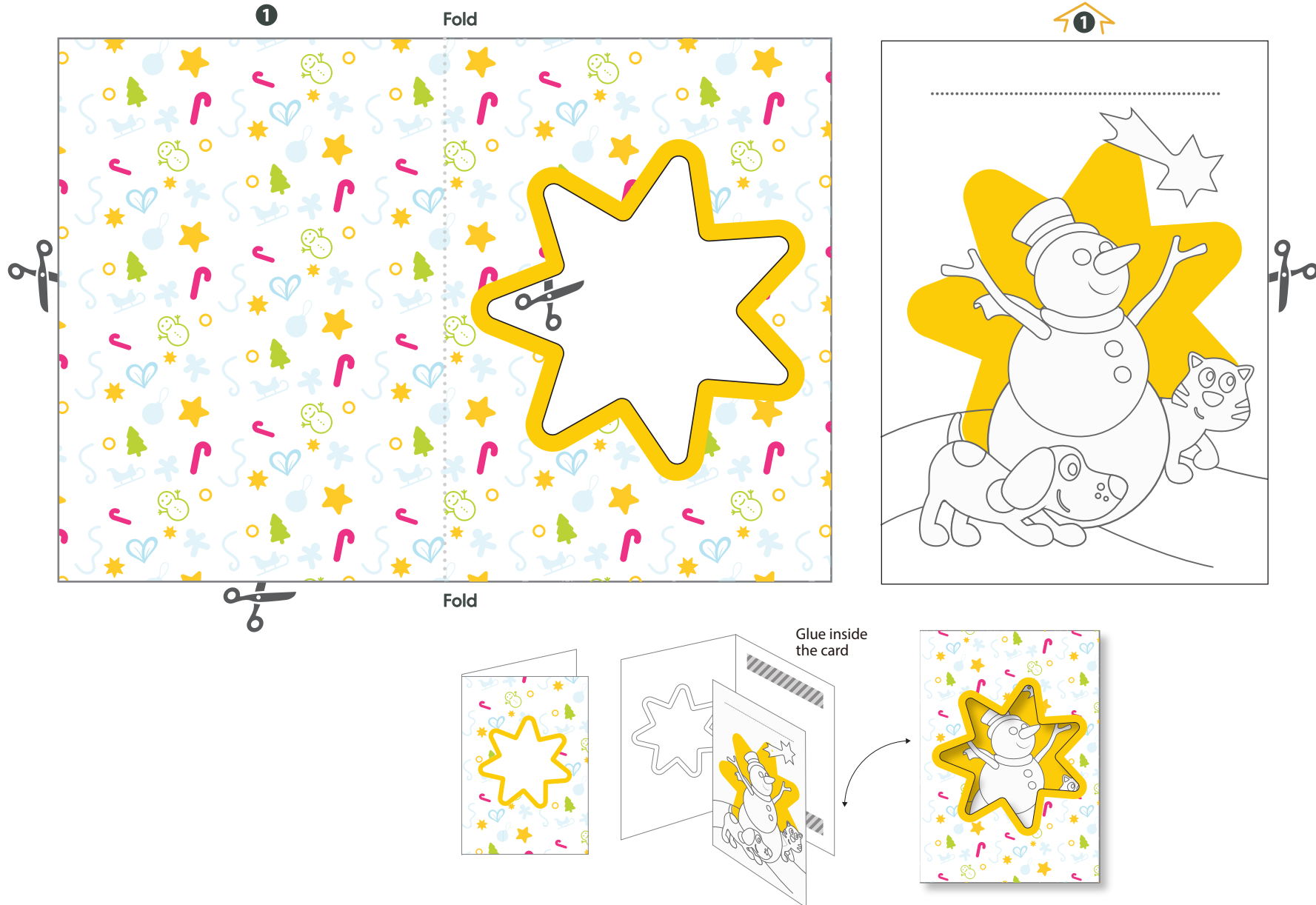
