



## Please read before starting installation:

1.

- Cover roof of vehicle with a protective blanket
- Inspect all components and verify all hardware is correct, present, and free of damage.
- Be mindful of scratching/damaging the powder coating while installing or using the rack, exposed metal will rust.
- 2 person installation is recommended. If you are unsure of the installation process, we recommend professional installation at your local installer or shop.
- Be aware that when installed, it will add additional height to your vehicle. Vehicles may no longer fit in garages, drive-thrus, or parking structures. Measure your vehicle's total height before attempting to enter one.
- Wait to tighten bolts until the entire rack is assembled, then tighten from the top down to ensure proper alignment. Double

# ADV CHASE RACK INSTALLATION GUIDE

### Step 1: Choose the type of install for your Bed Rails:


1. Install the ADV Bed Rail to the vehicles bed using either option 12 or 13 below, do not tighten at this time .

## OPTION 12: Under Bedrail Mounting

Threaded Clamp Block 4
M10 x 100 Full Thread 4
M10 std Nut 4
1/4 x 1" Allen Bolt 8
Round Face Plate 4


## OPTION 13 : Cargo Track / Uni-Track Mounting

Threaded Track Slider 6 Flange Bolts M10-40 6




### Step 2: Install RISERS

- 1. Using a 12" x 1/2" bolt, washers and Nylock nut
- 2. Assemble the Riser to the installed Bed Rail (Fig 2)
- 3. Lean Riser away from vehicle, tuck a protective cloth between Riser (#2) and Bed Rail (#1) to prevent damage to coating or truck.



### Step 3: Install OUTRIGGERS

- 1. Using M10X80mm bolts, attach the Outrigger (#4) to the Riser (#2) at the top bushing at 12 o'clock position. (Fig 4)
- 2. Rotate the Outrigger (#4) downward to line up with the lower bushing in the Riser (#2) and install M10 x 90mm bolt. (Fig 5)
- 3. The Outrigger (#4) is designed to be a snug fit to prevent rattling.
- 4. Install the m10 x 50mm bolt into the welded nut on the Riser (#2) to support the Outrigger (#4) at the desired Height.









### Step 4: Install Cross Tube and Bars:

- 1. Using 3/8" x 1.5" bolts, attach the Rear Cross Tube (#6) between the two Risers (#2) (Fig 6)
- 2. Install 3/8" carriage bolts UPWARD through the Outriggers (#4) though the Cross Bars (#7) secure with 3/8" Nylock nuts, Do not tighten yet. (Fig 7)
- 3. Install the Bump Stop (#9) to the furthest forward cross bar. Install a 3/8 x 1.5" Carriage bolt downward first through the Cross Bar (#7) through the Outrigger (#4) into the Threaded Bump Stop (#9) twist the Bump Stop to tighten the assembly together. (Fig 8)
- 4. IMPORTANT: The bump stops protect the Rack from striking the vehicle.

NOTE: Bump Stops should NOT be resting on the cab of the vehicle.






### **Step 5: Install Wind Faring:**

1. Using 1/4" bolts, washers & nuts, fasten the wind-faring (#8) onto the front of the outriggers (#4) (Fig 9)


## Step 6: Install Heim Rods:

- 1. Using m10 x 110 bolts, attach the Heim Rods (#9) to the welded Rear Cross Tube (#6)
- 2. Using m10x50mm bolts attach the other end of the Heim Rods to the Risers (#2)
- 3. Tighten Jam nuts on Heim Rods



### Step 7: Install Bed Rail to Bed Turn Buckles:

- 1. Install the Turn Buckles (#10) to your existing bed anchor location.
- 2. Find a rear anchor location in your lower back corner truck bed and hook one end of the Turn Buckle (#10) to the anchor location. The other end to the Bed Rail (#1).
- 3. Adjust the Turn Buckle (#10) hand tight, then using a 5/8" wrench turn in an additional 1/2 turn to secure.
- 4. Tighten Jam nut once turn buckle is snug.
