For best results apply when ants are most active, usually late afternoon. Follow-up visits should be made to inspect bait placement. Reapply as necessary.
Broadcast application		1 g per m²	Apply by shaking uniformly over lawns, gardens and other non-crop areas.
Ant mounds		20 g per colony or mound (approx 2 tablespoons)	Sprinkle around each mound (Do NOT use food utensils). For best results do not apply directly to the mound, nor disturb the ants or mound.
Indoor use	Ants and cockroaches	5-10 g per crack or crevice (approx 1 tablespoon) 1-2.5 g per m ²	Do NOT use in areas accessible to children. Indoor application is limited to inaccessible areas such as cracks and crevices, wall voids and crawl spaces in commercial and residential areas. Apply by shaking into cracks or crevices (Do NOT use food utensils). Remove any loose or excess granules. Apply to crawl spaces inaccessible to children and pets.
Outdoor use	Cockroaches	1-5 g per linear metre	Apply to external areas where large cockroach species are known to frequent e.g. around grease traps, manholes, sewers, etc.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

HYMENOPTHOR ULTRA Granular Insect Bait is suitable for controlling crawling insects in indoor and outdoor situations. The granules contain a special blend of foods plus fipronil insecticide. Worker ants carry the granules back to the nest. Expect to see fewer ants within one week. For indoor use, insect bait stations may be used.

APPLICATION

For outdoor broadcast applications use a hand held rotary spreader or similar device which will give uniform distribution. For smaller areas sprinkle uniformly by hand covered with rubber gloves.

For indoor applications use a suitable dust or granule applicator.

EOUIPMENT CLEANING

Equipment should be thoroughly cleaned before use and after use granules should be returned to the original sealed labelled container.

SPILLAGE

If product is spilt, collect or spread granules to discourage eating.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep out of reach of children. Store in the closed, original container in a dry, cool, well-ventilated area out of direct sunlight.

Do not dispose of undiluted chemicals on site. Dispose of used containers at a local authority landfill. If no landfill is available, bury the containers below 500 mm in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots.

Empty containers and product should not be burnt.
