# Description

High-density polyethylene square-mesh nets, knotted and mass UV-stabilised.

Chemically inert, rot-proof, highlyresistant to different weather conditions and a very wide range of chemicals.

Resistant from 430 kg/m², these nets are not anti-fall nets, which have different specifications.

# Fitting

First make a sketch to determine the number of eyes and turnbuckles needed.

Fix eyes every 50 cm around the perimeter and turnbuckles at corners.

Bring the stainless-steel wire rope through the eyes and tighten it with the turnbuckles

(1 eye every 10 meters).

Fix the wire rope to the turnbuckles with u-bolts.


Attach each mesh of the net to the wire rope with a ring (stainless-steel staple fastened with the net stapler).
