






FITTING THE FIRE

Use a blade to carefully cut the hearth edging tape on the side that the cable will be fed through to the mains socket.



Ensure the mains cable of the fire exits the same side of the suite where the mains socket is located. Check the supply cable is not trapped under the fire such that it may cause it to be damaged.



INSTALLING the fireplace


Fixing kit supplied with fireplace suites only



Note: Wall plugs supplied are for a solid wall. If screwing in to plaster board or wood, please use correct fixings.

- Fix the metal plate to the back of the fireplace as shown using the 4 x small screws supplied.
 (It is recommended to drill a 2mm pilot hole to prevent the wood splitting.)
- 2. Position the fireplace to the wall and mark through the 2 remaining holes.
- 3. Remove the fireplace then drill 6mm diameter holes aproximately 35mm deep. Insert the wall plugs.
- 4. Position the fireplace to the wall then screw through the plates in to the wall using the 2 x large screws provided.
