No collages, raised art or framed artwork allowed.

JUDGING CRITERIA

Judged equally on originality, artistic creativity and theme. The judges' decisions are final.

- 2) Entries must be original and completed by the participant without assistance.
- All entries become the property of Phoenix Chinese Week and may be used for displays and in Phoenix Chinese Week publications.
