

NEW THREADS

Sister by Studio Ashby has launched Jocasta, Sophie Ashby's debut fabric collection. The five new designs have been produced in collaboration with Yarn Collective, a company known for its natural and recycled textiles and climate-positive ethos. The new textiles include Patch in Cerulean (background fabric, below), priced at £170m, inspired by hardwearing and earthy kilims. Afua in Turmeric (front fabric), priced at £157.50m, has its roots in Sophie's husband's (fashion designer Charlie Casely-Hayford) Ghanaian heritage.



CENTRE OF ATTENTION

The Vienna dining table by Tom Faulkner, from £11,170, is inspired by the flowing curves of the art nouveau movement. The table's bold base, finished in Antique Bronze, creates a striking contrast to the Rosso Orobico marble top, with its softened corners creating a convivial seating arrangement, ideal for entertaining. With a range of tabletops and metalwork finishes to choose from, it is a luxury piece that will elevate any interior.








POETIC PALETTE
