

RING GAUGE To find your ring size, take one of your rings
(a simple band, for example, your wedding ring) and place it over one of the circles below
(note that finger size may vary from one hand to the other).

The inside edge of the ring must match the black circle on the chart, without any grey showing through.


Take down the number of the circle and enter it into your order form.

RING GAUGE FOR SIZING

We suggest that you print this page in full.

In order to make sure that the chart is the correct size, check that the following line measures 5cm:







BRACELETS The sizing chart must be printed in full on a sheet of A4 paper.

Make sure that the sizing chart has been printed in the right size by comparing measurements with a ruler.

Cut an opening, following the instructions 'CUT ALONG THIS LINE'.

Check that the numbers are on the outside of the sizing gauge and insert the pointed tip into the opening.

Put your hand through the loop and pull the tip until it comfortably fits your wrist.

For a 14.5cm measurement, choose a 15cm bracelet.

SIZING CHART FOR BRACELETS

To measure the size of your wrist, cut out the paper gauge below: 5cm
