Qua was born from the desire to breathe meaning into gifting, and as a brand, it is synonymous with meticulous artistry which crafts distinctive lacquerware that lasts generations.

SOCIALLY RESPONSIBLE GIFTS

At Qua, one of our specialties is translating art into lacquerware products. We have been working with special needs, differently-abled artists since 2011, creating a revenue stream for the artists. In doing so, we immortalise their creations, allowing them to sell more than just one painting at a time. We were the first in Singapore to work with the Pathlight School, and are now, we collaborate extensively with ART:DIS.

ART:DIS is the leading non-profit charity organisation dedicated to providing opportunities for persons with disabilities (PWDs) to be involved in the arts sphere. ART:DIS works to create and provide access and opportunities for PWDs through the arts. It promotes visual, performing and literary arts through various programmes and events for PWDs. ART:DIS has also established pathways for them to progress and excel in their fields and pursue a career in the arts. It created Singapore's first inclusive theatre and first inclusive literary art programme and was founded and launched by Ambassador-at-Large Prof Tommy Koh.

Qua believes in the important causes in Singapore and the non-profit organizations that strives to make a difference. Realising our CSR efforts through this collaboration, we aim to promote the art created by these unique and talented individuals as well as reach out to the public about people by special needs.


About the artist: Kenneth Lee



THE SINGAPORE HERITAGE

A melting pot of different cultures, languages and religion rooted in a cohesive multi-racial and multi-cultural society, Singapore is the wonderful blend of everything flavourful, of both old and new.

The Singapore Heritage series celebrates the rich combined history that we have as a nation. From the vibrant Peranakan culture to the time whereby we were not even yet a nation, the shared identity that we have serves as the perfect backdrop for the beautiful, luxurious lacquerware that is perfect for keepsakes.





SHOPHOUSE BLESSINGS





Qua x SCENE SHANG presents the Shophouse Blessings Series, inspired by Singapore's rich history and heritage found in shophouses. These desk organisers feature the key design elements of a Singaporean shophouse, namely – the facade, which is richly decorated with elements drawn from a mix of cultures across East and West; the side elevation, which features a pitched roof for our rainy weather, the five-foot way, designed to give passage to the community in all weather; and the slanted structure, which was done to cleverly take advantage of the maximum area when aligning the front facades along roads, as well as the back for the back lanes. In our Singapore Shophouse Blessings Series, we have included the characters in Chinese that are used to wish blessings upon the receiver, which can also be found on windows and doors of shophouses in Singapore. These elements of the facade together with the blessings are intricately painted with gold foil.

With the blessings '长发兴隆 - Always Thriving & Prosperous', '福乐安康 - Bliss, Joy, Peace, Health' and '和睦相处 - To Live in Harmony', this is the ideal practical gift to express your wishes while also serving as a keepsake.

The early Peranakans adopted the practice of incorporating expensive decorative ceramic tiles into the interior and exterior of their houses as a reflection of their extravagant lifestyle and status. The decorative tiles, usually in floral motifs, added a dash of vibrant colours into their Victorian-styled houses – which architecture reflect the East-West blend of the Straits Chinese. Through the modernisation of Singapore, the production of these tiles diminished slowly, along with the forgotten Peranakan heritage, and eventually have ceased to be mass-produced.

The Qua Ivory Nyonya Collection explores a modern twist to the classic Peranakan tiles, with the use of white and simpler colour palette for a more minimalistic look.

WILLIAM FARQUHAR



The William Farquhar Collection came from the very extensive watercolour drawings commissioned by William Farquhar, the first Resident and Commandant of Singapore (1819-1823), during his prior tenure as Resident of Melaka – there are 477 of these paintings that had been documented!

These natural history drawings depict the flora and fauna of the Malay Peninsula, most likely accomplished by local Chinese artists, with inscriptions identifying the species by their English and Malay names. Farquhar brought this set along with him when he left Singapore, and subsequently donated it to the Royal Asiatic Society in London in 1827. In 1993, it was put up for auction and purchased by Mr G.K. Goh, who had kindly donated the entire collection to the National Museum of Singapore.

We had selected a few of the paintings that best represent the spirit and history of its time and are great as gifts for a unique representation of Singapore.



HARMONY



The whole is greater than the sum of its parts – one of the cornerstones of Singapore's success is the diversity of our population while maintaining racial harmony. This cohesion between the racesand culture is definitely a quality that is unique in the world that is difficult to come by.

To celebrate this identity, Qua has designed the Harmony Collection, which was inspired by symbols of the main ethnic groups in Singapore: Malay, Indian, Chinese and Eurasian.

Malay: Inspired by the Malay culture of the "Wayang Kulit" (shadow puppet play) and the batik, we placed a spin on the symbolic patterns, vivid colours and shadow puppet figures.

Indian: The Indian design represents the tradition of "Rangoli" (traditional Indian folk art created on the floor using coloured rice, sand and flower petals) and henna painting (intricate hand tattoos adored by Indian women for festive occasions).

Chinese: Based on the Peony flower which embodies romance and prosperity, the Chinese has always been regarded as an omen of good fortune and a happy marriage. **Eurasian:** The Eurasians originated from the integration of the European traders and local populations that resulted in culture particular to their mixed heritage. This design is indicative of tiles Eurasian families would decorate their homes that have a mix of European and Asian influences.



VANDA MISS JOAQUIM



Vanda Miss Joaquim was chosen as Singapore's national flower back in 1981. The designation of a national flower was part of an overall effort to foster national pride and identity. Singapore has the unique distinction of being the only nation to have a hybrid as its national flower.

This collection highlights the simple, yet significant beauty of the Vanda Miss Joaquim.

ORCHID



Orchids are extremely popular as house plants, garden plants and corsage plants and can be found all over the world. There are over 20,000 accepted species of Orchids and are tremendously popular in the floral trade.

Horticulturists have also created over 100,000 Orchid hybrids and cultivars. Many hybrids are derived from the tropics in Asia and the orient as far down as Australia. They require warm growing conditions with plenty of bright light.

In April 1981, Vanda Miss Joaquim, a hybrid, was selected as the Singapore's National Flower. Orchids have since been widely use as Singapore's national symbol or as a token of appreciation during special events.
