



During real world evaluation, varieties are growing in several regions for which they have specific adaptability. Varieties are grown on commercial farms, using grower's own equipment.

Agitator

Agitator is an extremely tough variety that can tolerate both pre and post flowering stress. It has the desirable ability to adapt to changes in seasonal conditions, providing growers with consistent yields. It is dependable in good conditions but will outperform others when the going gets tough. Agitator is also appealing feed for cattle and can be utilised as a forage crop.

Agitator handles harsh and challenging growing conditions or double cropping situations extremely well. Be careful when spraying organophosphate in hot weather, as the insecticide can cause lea burn. Agitator is typically the first to flower - so be vigilant for midge. Be ready to harvest seven days after spraying out as Agitator dries down very quickly.

"Agitator gives you the best chance of getting a crop. Initially we utilised it as a risk mitigator yet it has proven to be at the very least, comparable to other varieties. This year has been one of our driest years and it has outperformed our expectations to what yields were achievable. Due to this, it is now one of my preferred varieties to grow." - Simon Currant, Comet Old.

Brazen

Brazen is a large leafy plant with a robust stem suited to deep soils and higher yield situations.

Brazen is more suitable for higher yielding soils, higher rainfall growing regions and good paddock conditions. Brazen has notable stress tolerance for maturity and standard spray-out management applies.

Anvil

Anvil is mid quick hybrid, which is of a more traditional nature having a higher tillering potential than Agitator or Brazen.

Capable of high yields due to its tightly packed semi-compact panicle but with only good stress tolerance compared to its compatriots. This, however, does not mean that standability is compromised. An excellent option in higher yield environments and good stores of soil moisture.

BMR

Incorporating the brown mid-rib (BMR) trait, Graze Maize provides a higher digestible forage option due to its lower lignin levels in better growing environments. Unlike the forage sorghums, BMR Graze maize does not have a risk of prussic acid poisoning and therefore provides a valuable alternative in suitable environments.

BMR Graze Maize also allows for a early plant option due to corn's higher vigour at colder temperatures compared to sorghum. BMR Graze Maize is however a single feed/cut option and is suited to direct grazing, green chopper and silage. Being a BMR corn it does not handle hot and dry conditions, if moisture is limiting, planting time should be thought through to avoid these conditions. Please call for further discussion on planting times.
