Club Car 4-Passenger Flip Flop Seat Kit 1981–UP DS Installation Instructions

Notes: Bill of Material is shown on Page 2. Quick Install Guide is shown on Page 2.

- 1. Remove top canopy and rear struts.
 - Keep strut hardware at front for 80" top (80" kit required) or older model standard tops (kit required). – OR –
 - Keep strut hardware at front & rear for newer model standard tops.
- 2. Remove seat back cushions from bag rack/sweater basket assembly and keep hardware for use in Step 11 below.
- 3. Remove bag rack/sweater basket assembly from vehicle.
- 4. Remove bumper.
- 5. Install Seat Back Support 'S' Brackets & Seat Back Support Posts. See Figure 1.

Use: Hardware Bag # 5 with 1/2" socket.

- 6. Install Footplate & Vertical Supports at the same time, using the bumper mounting holes. **See Figure 2.**
 - Use: **Hardware Bag # 1** with 17mm sockets. <u>Note:</u> Use only half of the hardware from Bag #1, the rest is used in Step 9.
 - ** TIP ** Use a floor jack to assist in the positioning of the Footplate.
- 7. Install Flip Flop Frame to Seat Back Support 'S' Brackets & Vertical Supports. **See Figure 3** for a view of the final assembly.

Use: Hardware Bag # 3 with 17mm socket & wrench.

8. Install Hand Rails to the sides of Flip Flop Frame. **See Figure 3.**

Use: Hardware Bag # 2 with 17mm wrench & #3 Phillips screw driver.

9. Install Hand Rails to the sides of Footplate. **See Figure 3.**

Use: Hardware Bag # 1 with 17mm sockets.

10. Install Rear Seat Back Bracket between Hand Rails. See Figure 3.

Use: Hardware Bag # 2 with 17mm socket & #3 Phillips screw driver.

11. Install front Seat Back Cushions. <u>Note:</u> For older model vehicles, (4) extra bolts are supplied in **Hardware Bag #4**.

Use: Hardware from Step 2 (newer model vehicles). Hardware Bag # 4 with 10mm socket (older model vehicles).

12. Install rear Seat Back Cushion.

Use: Hardware Bag # 4 with 10mm socket.

- Position Seat Bottom Cushion using (2) existing pilot holes in Seat Bottom Cushion and (2) wood screws. <u>Note:</u> Make sure the pull strap is not trapped under the cushion. Using drill, drill (6) additional pilot holes into Seat Bottom Cushion and then complete installation.
 - Use: 1/8" or 3mm drill bit.

Hardware Bag # 6 with #2 Phillips screw driver/drill bit.

14. Install top canopy using hardware from Step 1. <u>Note:</u> Separate instructions are included for installing newer model standard tops.
