Frosty's True Love Row by Row

FINISHED SIZE 30" x 10"



Materials Needed:

Background - 14" x WOF

White - 22" x 10" (body and head pieces)

Off White - Scrap 3" x 3" (eyes)

Black - 17" x 8" (hat, hat brim, inner eyes, mouth)

Red - 22" x 8" (scarf, hearts, hat band, dress, hair band)

Bright Red - Scrap (noses, mouth)

Grey - 10" x 10" (hair)

Additional Materials Needed:

Double-Stick Fusible Web

(Softfuse or Lite Steam-A-Seam Recommend)

H1. Heart H2. Heart H3. Heart

Thread (Black)

Dritz Fray-Check®

Open-toe applique sewing machine foot

(Optional but HIGHLY recommended).

Medium Tear-away Stabilizer

Embroidery Floss

Embroidery Needles

Pigma®Micron 01 Pen (Optional)

Cutting Instructions:

Notes: WOF=Width of fabric. Width of fabric is based on 42" of usable fabric with selvages removed)

BACKGROUND: Cut one 31" x 11" retangle.

Templates

Trim and tape all pattern template and diagram sheets where noted.

From the pattern sheet, carefully trace appliqué pattern pieces onto template material. Transfer all pattern numbers and instructions. See the "Skill Building" section on our website for additional appliqué preparation details, using templates and for a light box option (http://www.quiltingaffection.com/skill-building.htm).

Applique Placement:

Background:

With a pencil, lightly mark a 30 1/2" by 10 1/2" square on your background fabric. Center your appliqué pieces inside these lines and place according to the pattern placement diagram and project photo.

Remove the paper sheet that does not contain the sticky webbing from each pattern piece and discard. Position the pattern piece onto the WRONG SIDE of each appropriate piece of fabric and press according to manufacturer's instructions. Carefully cut along traced lines. Peel off paper backing and discard. The exposed webbing will be slightly sticky and the pattern piece may be moved around on the background fabric until you have achieved a satisfactory placement.

Eyeslashes and Smiles: These elements are marked on the placement template with dashed lines, trace them lighlty on your templates. These will be stitched after everything else is completed.

Use placement numbers, template instructions and project Placement Diagrams to position the appliqué pieces onto the background fabric. When all of the pattern pieces have been assembled to your satisfaction, fuse following the fusible webbing manufacturer's instructions.

IF ANY FRAYING OCCURS AT ANY POINT IN THE PLACEMENT OR APPLIQUÉ PROCESS, APPLY A BEAD OF "Dritz Fray-Check®" AROUND THE PATTERN PIECE AND TRIM AWAY ANY FRAYED THREADS.

TIP:

You may first assemble the main appliqué pieces on a non-stick pressing sheet used for Appliqué or a piece of parchment paper. (See the "Skill Building" on our website for technique (http://www.quiltingaffection.com/skill-building.htm))

Applique Sewing Instructions:


USING AN OPEN-TOE SEWING MACHINE FOOT WILL GREATLY IMPROVE THE APPEARANCE AND THE EASE OF APPLIQUEING AROUND THE PATTERN PIECES.


After permanently fusing the appliqué to the background fabric, stitch around each pattern piece using a small blanket stitch. (See "Skill Building" section on our website for detailed instructions on threads, needles and beginning and ending each line of stitching (http://www.quiltingaffection.com/skill-building.htm)).


Eyeslashes and Smiles: Use 2 strands of black embroidery floss and short embroidery stitches to add the eyelashes and smiles permentaly.

Trim Background:

After appliqué stitching all of the fused pattern pieces onto the 31" x 11" background fabric, remeasure the 30 1/2" x 10 1/2" pencil markings to ensure they have not stretched. Remark if necessary and trim.
