


BLOCK PARTY BLOCK #10 X Marks the Spot










Cutting Instructions: Per Block

Units Name and # of Units	6"	12"	18″
A: Shaded Four Patch	2" Finished	4" Finished	6" Finished 61/2" cut sized
4 Units	2 ½" cut sized	4 ½" cut sized	
B: Flying Geese	1" x 2" Finished	2" x 4" Finished	3" x 6" Finished
4 Units	1 1/2" x 2 1/2" cut sized	2 1/2" x 4 1/2" cut sized	3 ½" x 6 ½" cut sized
C: Flying Geese	1" x 2" Finished	2" x 4" Finished	3" x 6" Finished
4 Units	1 1/2" x 2 1/2" cut sized	2 ½" x 4 ½" cut sized	3 1/2" x 6 1/2" cut sized
D: Square	2" Finished	4" Finished	6" Finished
1 Square	2 1/2" cut sized	4 ½" cut sized	6 1/2" cut sized








Block Assembly

- 1. Lay out the block according to the layout diagram shown.
- 2. Stitch the units into rows, pressing as you desire.
- Stitch the rows together, pressing as you desire.
 Make (1) Block.




