

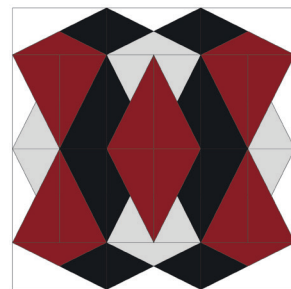

Take your Split Rects skills to the next level, in this Advanced Block that uses the Split Rects Bonus Units to make this block. I recommend pressing your seam open when making this block. Play with color to build the depth that makes the Diamonds stand out.

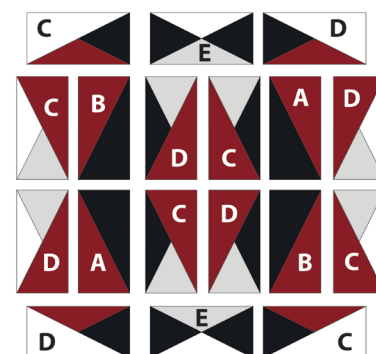

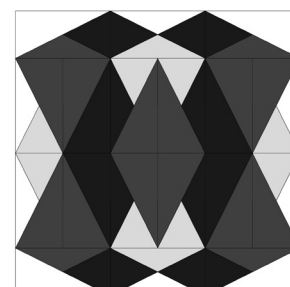
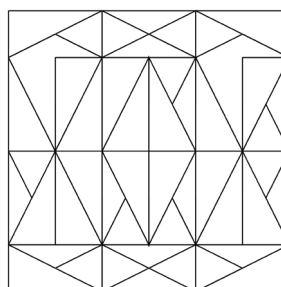

Cutting Instructions: Per Block

Units Name and # of Units	6"	12"	18"
A: Split Rects Type 1 2 Units	1" x 2" Finished 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" cut sized	2" x 4" Finished 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" cut sized	3" x 6" Finished 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" cut sized
B: Split Rects Type 2 2 Units	1" x 2" Finished 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" cut sized	2" x 4" Finished 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" cut sized	3" x 6" Finished 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" cut sized
C: Enlongated Combination Type 1 3 Units	1" x 2" Finished 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" cut sized	2" x 4" Finished 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" cut sized	3" x 6" Finished 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" cut sized
D: Enlongated Combination Type 2 3 Units	1" x 2" Finished 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" cut sized	2" x 4" Finished 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" cut sized	3" x 6" Finished 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" cut sized
D: Hourglass 2 Units	1" x 2" Finished 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" cut sized	1 1/2" Finished Size / Cut Away Size	2 3/4" Finished Size / Cut Away Size



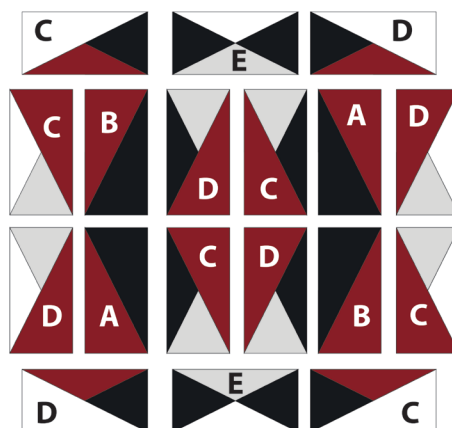
Note: Please remember to read your tool instructions thoroughly before using them.



Block Assembly

1. Lay out the block according to the layout diagram shown.
2. Stitch the units into rows, pressing as you desire.
3. Stitch the rows together, pressing as you desire.

Make (1) Block.

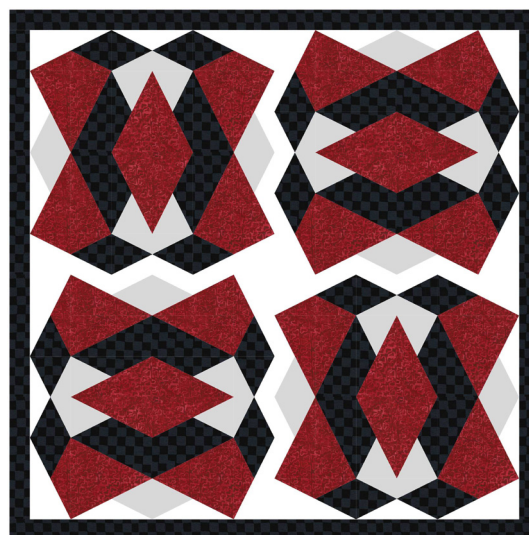
