With this paper-piecing-looking block, you can bring some ice into your house. By taking and popping some of the corners with your Studio 180 Design Corner Pop II tool, you will make some unique shapes that make this block so fascinating.

Using the blocks cutting chart below, determine the size you wish to make. Refer to the Corner Beam®, V Block® Trimmer, Large Square Squared®, Corner Pop®, and Corner Pop® II tool instructions. It is recommended that you press the seams open when constructing the block.

When your units are complete, assembly your block carefully. Making the inside block first and then adding the outside units. Pressing all you seams open is highly recommend when assembling the block.

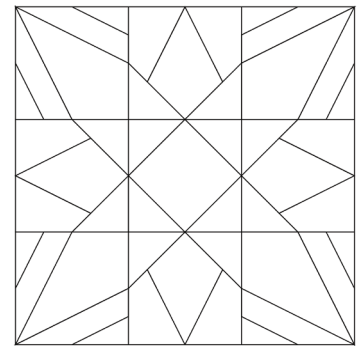
A: Popped Corner Beams



B: Popped V Block

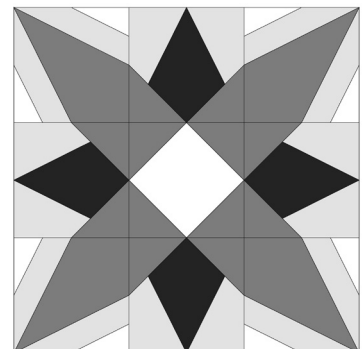
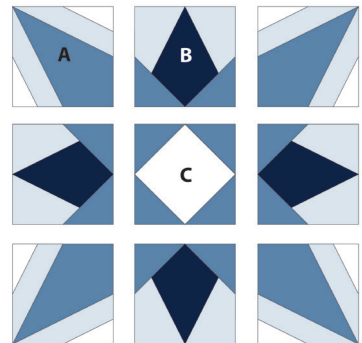

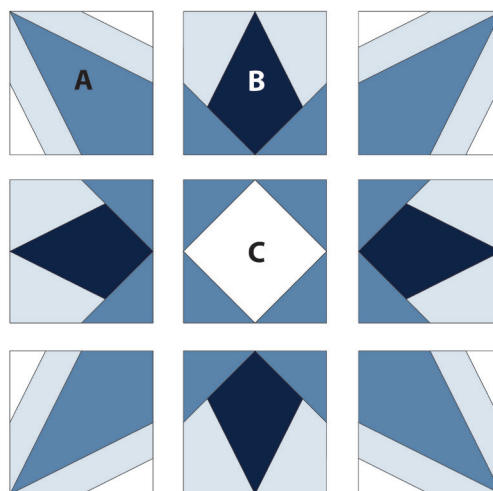

Block Assembly

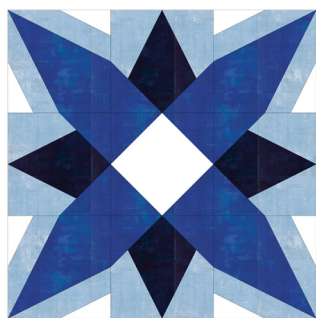
1. Lay out the block according to the layout diagram shown.
2. Stitch the units into rows, press seams open.
3. Stitch the rows together, press seams open.

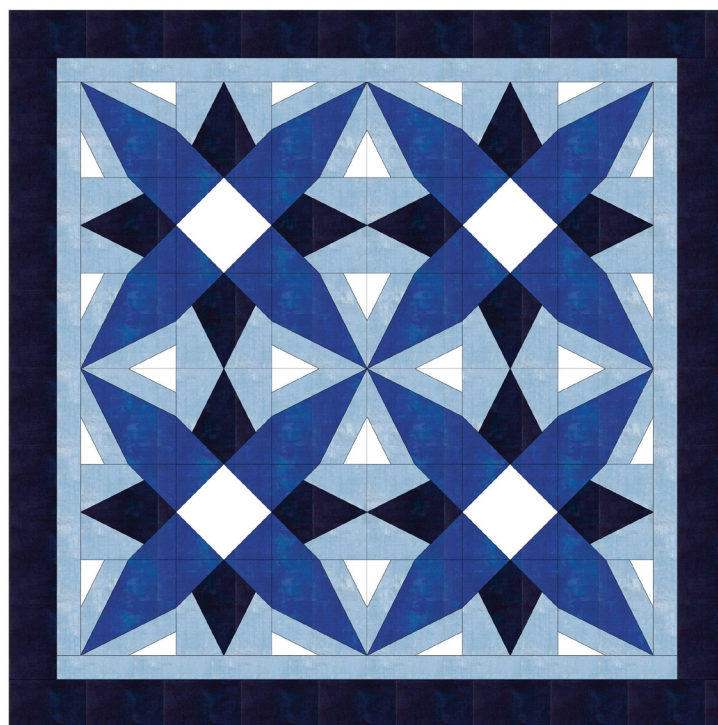
