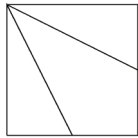
Blowing Leaves, reminds me of the wind taking hold of the leaves and putting a spin on them in the air. This simple block uses the Studio 180 Design Corner Beam and Pickets & Quickets Technique to make the many parts of the leaves, you will finish the block by adding a Multi-Colored Square Squared unit in the center. to make them all flow together.

Using the blocks cutting chart below, determine the size you wish to make. Refer to the Corner Beam®, Square Squared®, and Wing Clipper® tool instructions. You will also need the Pickets & Quickets Technique Sheet.

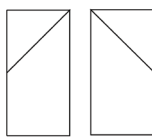

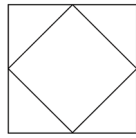

B: Quickets

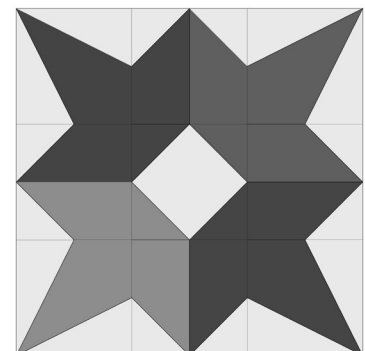
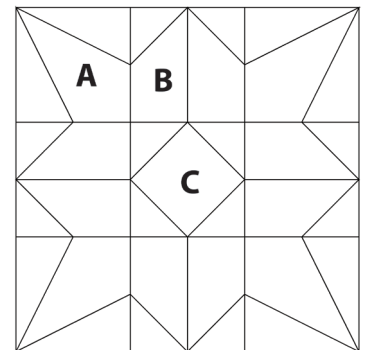


C: Square Squared



Cutting Instructions: Per Block

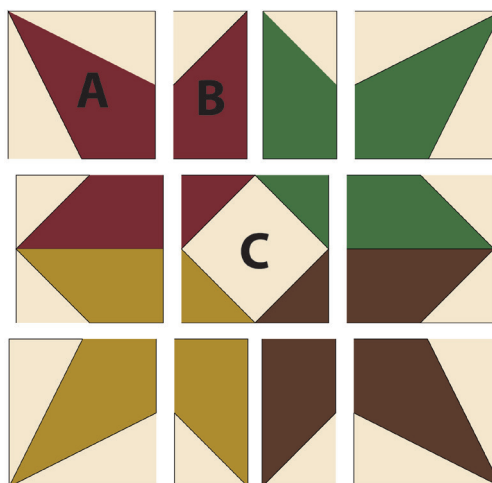
Units Name and # of Units	9"	12"	16"
A: Corner Beam 4 units	3" Finished 3 ½" cut sized	4" Finished 4 ½" cut sized	6" Finished 6 ½" cut sized
B: Quickets 8 units	1 ½" x 3" Finished 2" x 3 ½" cut sized	2" x 4" Finished 2 ½" x 4 ½" cut sized	3" x 6" Finished 3 ½" x 6 ½" cut sized
D: Square Squared 1 Units	3" Finished 3 ½" cut sized	4" Finished 4 ½" cut sized	6" Finished 6 ½" cut sized



Block Assembly

1. Lay out the block according to the layout diagram shown.
2. Stitch the units into rows, press seams open.
3. Stitch the rows together, press seams open.

Make (1) Block.
