
D & E: Squares



### **Cutting Instructions: Per Block**

Units Name and # of Units	6″	12″	18″
A: Half Square Triangles	1" Finished	2" Finished	3" Finished
4 Units	1 ½" cut sized	2 ½" cut sized	3½" cut sized
B: Flying Geese	2" Finished	4" Finished	6" Finished
4 Units	2 ½" cut sized	4 ½" cut sized	6 ½" cut sized
C: Square Squared	2" Finished	4" Finished	6" Finished
4 Units	2 ½" cut sized	4 ½" cut sized	6 ½" cut sized
D: Squares	1″ Finished	2" Finished	3" Finished
4 Square	1 ½″ cut sized	2 ½" cut sized	3 ½" cut sized
E: Square	2″ Finished	4" Finished	6″ Finished
1 Square	2 ½″ cut sized	4 ½" cut sized	6 ½″ cut sized




# **Block Assembly**

- 1. Lay out the block according to the layout diagram shown.
- 2. Stitch the units into rows, pressing as you desire.
- Stitch the rows together, pressing as you desire.
  Make (1) 12 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" square Block.
