
B: Split Rects Type 2





Cutting Instructions: Per Block

Units Name and # of Units	6″	12″
A: Split Rect Type 1	1" x 2" Finished	2" x 4" Finished
4 Units	1 ½" x 2 ½" cut sized	2 ½" x 4 ½" cut sized
B: Split Rects Type 2	1" x 2" Finished	2" x 4" Finished
4 units	1 ½" x 2 ½" cut sized	2 ½" x 4 ½" cut sized
C: Rectangles	³ ⁄ ₄ " x 1 ¹ ⁄ ₄ " Finished	1 ½" x 2 ½" Finished
1 unit	1 ¹ ⁄ ₄ " x 1 ¹ ⁄ ₂ " cut sized	2" x 3" cut sized
D: Small Squares	³ ⁄4" Finished	1 ½" Finished
4 squares	1 ¹ ⁄4" cut sized	2" cut sized
E: Medium Squares	1 ¼″ Finished	2 ½" Finished
4 squares	1 ½″ cut sized	3" cut sized
F: Large Squares	2" Finished	4" Finished
4 square	2 ½" cut sized	4 ½" cut sized






Block Assembly

- 1. Lay out the block according to the layout diagram shown.
- 2. Stitch the units into rows, pressing as you desire.
- Stitch the rows together, pressing as you desire.
 Make (1) Block.


