


BLOCK PARTY BLOCK #6 Jacks

This block reminds me of my childhood playing with my Jacks. This block pattern uses the Studio 180 Design tool, Corner Beam®, Corner Pop®, and Wing Clipper® tools to make this block come to life.

B: Flying Geese





A: Popped Corner Beam 4 Units	2" Finished 2 1/2" cut sized	4" Finished 4 1/2" cut sized	3" Finished 3½" cut sized
Finished Size / Cut Away Size on Corner Pop Tool	1" Finished Size / Cut Away Size	2" Finished Size / Cut Away Size	3" Finished Size / Cut Away Size
B: Flying Geese 4 Units	1" x 2" Finished 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" cut sized	2" x 4" Finished 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" cut sized	3" x 6" Finished 3 ½" x 6 ½" cut sized
C: Popped Square 1 square	2" Finished 2 1/2" cut sized	4" Finished 4 1/2" cut sized	6" Finished 6 ½" cut sized




Block Assembly

- Stitch the rows together, pressing as you desire.
 Make (1) Block.


