## QUICK START GUIDE

Congratulations on your purchase of the WaveShark Communicator device. We hope that the WaveShark Communicator will help you fulfill all of your disaster preparedness and other off-grid communications needs. We have prepared the following **QUICK START GUIDE** to help you get up and running as quickly as possible.

1. All WaveShark Communicators have their internal high-capacity battery fully charged before shipping. To recharge this battery after use, simply plug the device into a USB port using the included USB cable. The battery will also automatically recharge during use if the WaveShark Communicator is plugged into USB power.
2. Download the **WaveShark Communicator User Manual** and acquaint yourself with your new WaveShark Communicator device. The WaveShark Communicator is designed to be easily used right out of the box, but also hosts a number of advanced features that you might want to make use of. **WaveShark app for Android devices**, downloadable via the **Google Play Store**
