These instructions are for an alternative center unit to be used with the Shine Together quilt pattern. Unit will measure 6" $\times 6$ " finished $\left(6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2}\right.$ " unfinished)

## NOTES

- Seam Allowance = $1 / 4$
- Press all seams open unless otherwise stated.

| Color 3 - Light | $221 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 21 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ |



## SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

1. On the wrong side of the Background 4 " squares, mark a diagonal line from corner to corner. Fig 1
2. Pair one Background 4 " square with one Color 1 (Dark) 4 " squares. Sew $1 / 4$ " away of the marked line on both sides on both pairs. Fig 2
3. Cut on the marked line. Fig $\mathbf{3}$ Press seams open or to the dark side. Trim HSTs to $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.
4. Repeat Step 2 with one Hush Hush 4" square and one Medium color 4 " square. Fig 4
5. On the wrong side of the Medium and Light $21 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares, mark a diagonal line from corner to corner. Fig 5
6. Place one Color 3 (Light) $2^{1 ⁄ 1 / 4}$ " square on the corner of one Color 2 (Medium) HST. Fig 6

8. Repeat Steps 6 and 7 with Color 2 (Medium) 2¼" squares and Color 1 (Dark) HSTs to create a total of four sub-units. Fig 8
9. Sew units from Steps 7-8 together, making sure to alternate colors to create contrast as seen in Fig 9, 10 , and 11 . Unit should measure $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
10. Use Star Block Assembly Method in the Shine Together pattern to complete block. Fig 12
