
These instructions are for an alternative center unit to be used with the Shine Together quilt pattern. Unit will measure 6" x 6" finished (6½" x 6½" unfinished)



## NOTES


- Seam Allowance = ¼"
- Press all seams open unless otherwise stated.

MATERIALS	CUTTING
BACKGROUND (Hush Hush 3)	<b>2</b> 4" × 4"
Color 1 - Dark	1 4" x 4"
Color 2 - Medium	<b>1</b> 4" × 4" <b>2</b> 2¼" × 2¼"
Color 3 - Light	<b>2</b> 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> " × 2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>4</sub> "



## SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

- On the wrong side of the Background 4" squares, mark a diagonal line from corner to corner. Fig 1
- Pair one Background 4" square with one Color 1 (Dark) 4" squares. Sew ¼" away of the marked line on both sides on both pairs. Fig 2
- 3. Cut on the marked line. **Fig 3** Press seams open or to the dark side. Trim HSTs to 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" square.
- 4. Repeat Step 2 with one Hush Hush 4" square and one Medium color 4" square. **Fig 4**
- On the wrong side of the Medium and Light 2¼" squares, mark a diagonal line from corner to corner. Fig 5
- Place one Color 3 (Light) 2¼" square on the corner of one Color 2 (Medium) HST. Fig 6
- Sew on the marked line. Trim corner leaving ¼" seam allowance and discard excess. Fig 7. Press seam. Repeat with remaining Color 3 (Light) 2¼" square and Color 2 (Medium) HST.
- Repeat Steps 6 and 7 with Color 2 (Medium) 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" squares and Color 1 (Dark) HSTs to create a total of four sub-units. Fig 8



- 9. Sew units from Steps 7- 8 together, making sure to alternate colors to create contrast as seen in Fig 9, 10, and 11. Unit should measure 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>"
- 10. Use Star Block Assembly Method in the Shine Together pattern to complete block. Fig 12
