

Argan Oil – (Argania Spinosa Kernel Oil) is obtained from the fruit kernel of the Argan Tree. Rich in Vitamin E, antioxidants, omega-6 and omega-9 essential fatty acids all of which assist in keeping skin nourished and hydrated

**Rice Bran Oil** – the main benefit of rice bran oil to the skin is its wonderful deep-moisturizing capability. This is due to its combination of vitamin E and fatty acids, which go deep into skin to hydrate. ... Rice bran oil is light and penetrates easily, so it's not likely to increase the oiliness of your skin.
