# MudSling<sup>®</sup> R nineT Installation Guide

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- \* Before beginning work, read these instructions from start to finish.
- \* On level ground, place bike on side stand or on center stand.
- \* MudSling can be installed without removing the rear wheel.

#### Parts:

- 1 MudSling R nineT
- 4 Washers
- 2 M5 x25mm Torx Screw
- 2 M5 x10mm Torx Screw
- 2 M5 Stand-Off

### **Tools required:**

10mm Open End Wrench T-25 Torx Driver

#### Additional Tools required for R nineT Standard Models:

2mm Allen Wrench/Key T-25 Torx Drive Socket and Ratchet Wrench


# **NOTE:** Installation differs between the standard R nineT and it's variants:

### **R** nineT STANDARD

Begin installation at **Step 1** on page 2. The standard model is equipped with a preload adjuster on the OEM shock. To provide sufficient clearance for the MudSling, the preload body position must be rotated and the adjustment knob removed.

PURE SCRAMBLER URBAN G/S RACER Begin installation on page 2.

*Begin installation on page 2. No special adjustments are needed.* 



## \*Charcoal Canister Differences R nineT Standard Models Only



MudSling WILL FIT models with small charcoal cannister - model years 2017~19.



MudSling WILL NOT FIT models with large charcoal cannister - model years 2014 ~16.

**Note:** The size of Charcoal cannisters fitted to North American, European, and Asian models for the model years listed above may differ in your market.

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Begin with Step 3 for R nineT Pure, Scrambler, Urban GS and Racer.



#### R nineT standard and certain 2021 models:

Remove the preload adjustment knob. To break the grip of Loctite, use a Ratchet Wrench with a T25 Torx driver. Hold knob securely to prevent it from turning while screw is being removed.

Using a 2mm hex tool, loosen the set screw indicated. **Note:** Be careful not to strip the screw. If there is any concern about handling this Step, contact a qualified BMW motorcycle technician.



R nineT standard and certain 2021 models:

Rotate the shock so the knob shaft faces the right hand side of the motorcycle. Using a 2mm hex tool, re-tighten the set screw. **Do not re-install the preload adjustment knob.** It will interfere with the brake fluid reservoir. To adjust the shock after installing the MudSling, use an 8mm socket or open end wrench. **Proceed with Step 3.** 



**Remove the four screws** indicated using a T-25 torx driver. These screws will not be re-used.



**Install the supplied stand offs** into the two forward most mounting locations. Tighten using a 10mm wrench.



**Position the MudSling forward and low**, then lift to align its mounting holes with the Stand-offs and rear mounting holes.



**Add a washer to each M5 Torx head screw.** Insert an M5 x10 screw through the MudSling and into each stand-off, and an M5 x 25 screw through the rear holes of the MudSling into the frame threads. Tighten all screws with a T25 Torx driver.

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
