Our Journey

In 2015, Sewa International started the “#Yes! I can go to school” program, and implemented the first pilot project by installing toilets at four government schools in Jigani, Bengaluru District, in South India. Girl's school attendance increased by 87%.

Since then, Sewa International has expanded the project to different locations across India. In the past five years, this project has benefited more than 9,927 families and 43,989+ school children from various sections of Indian communities.

Key Focus Areas

Our Key Focus Area:

1. Building new toilets/repairing existing toilets in schools with a higher percentage of girl students.
2. Construction of menstrual rooms for adolescent girls and female school staff.
3. Providing water for sanitation.

There are several 'rights' given to citizens of India but the right to a safe, secure, and healthy life at home and in schools is not one of them. Thus, we believe a “Right to Sanitation Facilities”, especially for our women and girl children who face several challenges everyday just to attend nature calls in a safe and secure environment, is much needed.

SHE team is committed to providing such toilet facilities in communities, neighbourhoods, and schools, where they are not available so that we can ensure both dignity and safety to women and girl children.

Key requirements:

- 6 new toilets in rural Fatehpur school
- soak pit; overhead tank
- water provision for sanitation; wash basin installation

Name of the identified school: Govt primary school, Bhagaonpur

Total School Strength : 115 students, 5 staff

Requirements at the school post survey and analysis:

- 6 new toilets/urinals for students and teachers.
- Construction of new soak pit for sanitation.
- Overhead tank to provide water for sanitation; Water connection inside the toilet units.
- Wash basin outside the toilet block.

The identified school is in a very remote rural area with limited facilities for water and sanitation; Children walk through 2-3 villages everyday to commute to school. Lack of proper sanitation facilities causing a lot of health issues for students.

Sewa received a request letter from Fatehpur Education department, Govt of UP requesting help with sanitation facilities in this school.

With generous funds from our young donor Ayan Mishra, Sewa is providing sanitation facilities at this school.

Scope of Work

Govt primary school, Bhagaonpur Scope includes:

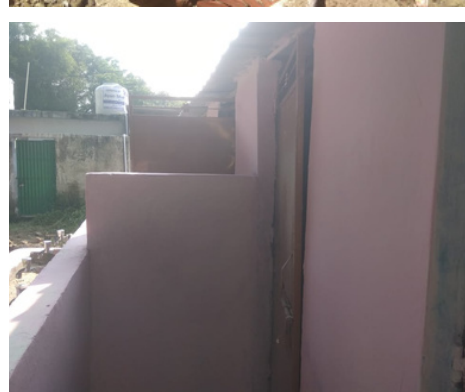
- 1 toilet block with 3 toilet units for Boys and 1 toilet block with 3 toilet units for girl students
- 1 soak pit construction
- Overhead tank (500 ltrs) that can supply water for all the toilet units
- Water connection inside the toilets
- Wash basin outside the toilet block
- Menstrual health and awareness workshops and distribution of reusable sanitary napkin kits for all adolescent girls students.
- Self defense and mental wellness sessions planned for the girl students in these schools.

Project construction:

Aug- Sep 2022

Post construction, Sewa will provide 6 months maintenance of the toilets before handover to the local authorities. Regular visits, any minor repairs, awareness and training to the school on long term maintenance of the toilets will be done during the maintenance period.

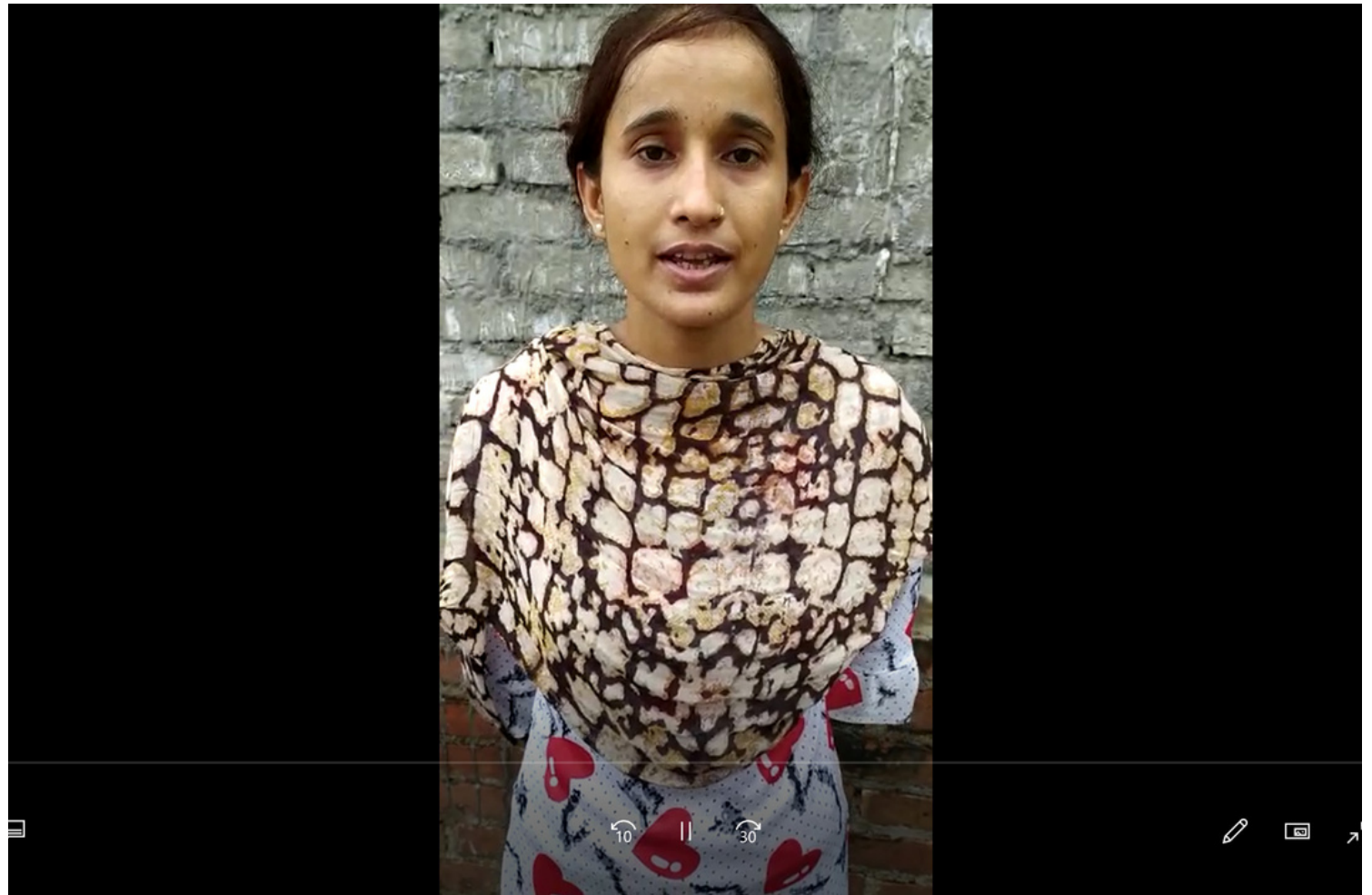
