## **Project Details**

Sewa team conducted surveys and identified beneficiaries across Uttar Pradesh, Kerala Andhra Pradesh, West Bengal, Maharashtra and Delhi.

Some of the camps were conducted for covid impacted women who are undergoing livelihood skill development training under our SHE-CAF program. Rest of the camps were conducted for adoloscent girls in schools.

- 2. To educate and make them aware about the environmental pollution and health hazards associated with using disposable sanitary napkins. Create awareness about covid pandemic and vaccination.
- 3. To distribute Re-usable Sanitary napkin kits.

#### Beneficiaries:

A total of 1027 underprivileged adolescent girls and women.

#### **Activities Conducted:**

- 1. Audio/Video session About menstrual hygiene, covid awareness.
- 2. Information session on Sewa's cloth sanitary napkin (usage, benefits, wash & dry instructions).
- 3. Question and Answer session.
- 4. Distribution of re-usable sanitary napkins.
- 5. Water and snacks for all the beneficiaries.
