# AUG KEY HIGHLIGHTS

## SANITATION

- 80% completion of toilet construction work in Kanpur, UP and Viratnagar, Rajasthan.  
Target completion: early September.
- Inauguration of newly constructed toilets across schools in Kanpur & Viratnagar.
- Repairs of existing toilets across schools in Maharashtra, Ayodhya and North Karnataka.



**54 new toilets being constructed across schools in Kanpur and Viratnagar.**  
**Repairs of 23 existing toilets across schools in Maharashtra, UP and North Karnataka**



## MENSTRUAL AWARENESS

- Camps for adolescent girls in Kanpur schools where toilets are being constructed by Sewa.
- Menstrual health and awareness camps across Karnataka as a part of Oracle funded India project.
- Camps for SHE-CAF beneficiaries in Thrissur, Kerala
- Total beneficiaries - 466 Adolescent girls

### Focus Areas:

- Menstrual health and awareness sessions.
- Distribution of reusable cloth sanitary napkins to girl students from class 7 - 10 and SHE-CAF beneficiaries.
- Q&A sessions with students.

## SHE-CAF

- **Beneficiaries undergoing the training:** 502
- **Beneficiaries completed their trainings and got jobs/self employed:** 384
- **Beneficiaries whose trainings will start in Sep:** 167
- **Target Beneficiaries:** Covid impacted women from Urban, Rural & Tribal areas, Transgender community, Migrant workers.
- **Ongoing programs:** Regional skill development (kalamkari art, puppets, dolls, crochet, apiculture, aquaculture, medicinal plants etc), weaver empowerment, micro enterprise, livestock rearing, skill development trainings (computer, beauty, tailoring etc), tribal livelihood, Agri farming etc.

# SANITATION - NEW TOILET CONSTRUCTION



## Construction of toilets in Kanpur and Viratnagar

### Kanpur & Viratnagar:

Our team is working on construction of new toilet units across 3 schools in Kanpur and 5 schools in Viratnagar with support of local volunteers and civil engineers.

Toilets in Uchha Prathamik vidyalaya, Kanpur was inaugurated on Aug 22, 2022 by Akhilesh Ji (Prant Vibhag Pracharak) and Navendu Ji (Sewa Bharati Prant Mahamantri).

Toilets in Rajkiya Uchprathamik vidyalaya, Devali, Viratnagar was inaugurated on independence day by district education officer Ratiram Bunkar Ji

- 6 toilet units is being constructed in each of the identified schools.
- Provision of overhead tank, water source & wash basin unit
- Building a new septic tank for the toilet units.

### Scope of work - Viratnagar

Funded by Riya Dadheech, Purple Paint

Project Status - 80% completion of work

- Total schools identified : 5 Govt schools.
- A total of 36 toilet units is being constructed across 5 schools.
- Building a new soak pit for the toilet units for sanitary outlet.
- Overhead tank and Wash basin outside the toilet unit blocks.

Our team has identified schools with non functional toilet units which need help with sanitation. We have completed the need analysis and survey of these non functional toilet units.

Our team will be undertaking repairs of toilets at schools across North Karnataka, Ayodhya and Maharashtra.

### Scope of work - Gadag

Govt Girls high school , Nargund, North Karnataka

- Repairs - both major and minor repairs of 8 non functional toilet units will be undertaken
- Provision of overhead tank & wash basin unit

# MENSTRUAL AWARENESS



## Menstrual Health and Awareness for Adolescent girls

### Key Activities:

- Awareness to students on women's health and hygiene.
- Awareness on menstrual hygiene through educational videos and other collateral.
- Discussions on menstrual health & biological changes that happen to a girl upon puberty.
- We had beneficiaries interact with our volunteer/gynecologist to answer all their fears and queries about puberty and menstruation.
- Talk about the various myths in the society so that girls face puberty with positive mind set.
- Distribute reusable cloth sanitary napkins, These are eco friendly, washable & reusable for up to 2 yrs.
- Q&A sessions with students.

- **Karnataka – Bangalore Urban , Chamarajanagar ;** Regional skill development – stitching Kaudi blankets; Beauty and bridal makeup; Bridal flower making & Arni embroidery; Yoga/Fitness trainer certification; Micro enterprise(Rotti making)
- **Telangana – Puttapaka;** Weaver empowerment
- **Andhra Pradesh - Ingalur Village,Srikalahasti;** Regional skill development – Kalamkari block and hand painting
- **West Bengal – Phulia;** Weaver empowerment; Nakshikanta embroidery

- **Madhya Pradesh – Singhrauli;** Natural farming

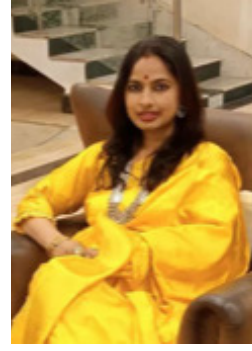
