SHE - SANITATION, HYGIENE AND EMPOWERING THE GIRL CHILD



MAY KEY HIGHLIGHTS

SANITATION

- Ongoing construction of 8 new toilets across 2 rural schools in Sagara, Shivamogga District, Karnataka.
- Expanded our sanitation project reach to Chattisgarh. We Initiated the construction of 12 toilets in schools across tribal areas of Durg, Chattisgarh. Our ground team did a small bhoomi puja to initiate the construction work.
- Identified schools in Hamirpur, Uttar Pradesh for sanitation work.
- 42 new toilets built in schools across UP and Rajasthan with generous funds from Google and North Jersey LEAD(batch of 2022).

MENSTRUAL HYGIENE

- Menstrual health and hygiene camps conducted in schools across viratnagar and Ayodhya.
- Distribution of reusable cloth sanitary napkin kits to adolescent girl students .
- Total beneficiaries covered -616.

Focus Areas:

- Menstrual health and awareness sessions.
- Distribution of reusable cloth sanitary napkins to girl students from class 7 10 and SHE-CAF beneficiaries.
- Q&A sessions with students.

SHE-CAF

- Beneficiaries undergoing the training: 802.
- Beneficiaries completed their trainings and got jobs/self employed: 854. New registrations received: 250.
- Target Beneficiaries<u>:</u> Covid impacted women from Urban, Rural & Tribal areas, Transgender community, Migrant workers.
- Ongoing programs: Regional skill development(kalamkari art, wrought iron idols, wooden cutlery, puppets, dolls, crochet, arni embroidery, aquaculture, Kaudi blankets, Bandhej, medicinal plants etc), weaver empowerment, micro enterprise, livestock rearing, skill development trainings(computer, beauty, tailoring, digital literacy etc), tribal livelihood, Agri farming etc.
- Expanding SHE-CAF programs to a new state ,Jharkhand.
- Newer programs for transgender and other marginalized communities.
- In progress website to create an online platform for women artisans & weavers, SHE helpline number for beneficiary connect.

SPOTLIGHT #1 EMPOWERING TRANS LIVES, INSPIRING CHANGE

- Sewa International's Covid Affected Families (CAF) project has launched various training programs for the transgender community. This is an initiative to empower marginalized communities and enable them to gain a sustainable livelihood.
- Over 64 transgender beneficiaries are currently being supported through various empowerment programs across Karnataka, West Bengal and Telangana. In the coming months, we will be expanding our transgender programs to other states across India.
- Training programs include tailoring & embroidery, beauty & makeup, operating and maintaining garlic peeling devices, managing a mobile food truck, tiffin center and setting up paper plate manufacturing unit.

SPOTLIGHT #2 SHE MODEL VILLAGE- RAJASTHAN





Successfully piloted model village in Rajasthan to increase SHE program impact.

SHE and CAF programs implemented across 20 villages in Viratnagar, Rajasthan.

Programs including improved sanitation facilities in schools,providing water for drinking & sanitation, menstrual awareness sessions,yoga and mental wellness, self defense workshops, skill development training for underprivileged women implemented.

SANITATION - NEW TOILET CONSTRUCTION



Construction of toilets in Coastal areas of Karnataka,Hamirpur, UP and Tribal area of Chattisgarh

- Two underprivileged schools was identified in coastal areas of Karnataka -Sagara taluk ,Shivamogga ; Sewa is building 4 toilets each in these schools.
- Three new schools have been identified in Tribal areas of Durg in Chattisgarh; Our ground team did the bhoomi puja to mark the initiation of construction work. The team is procuring all the construction materials and the construction is planned to start in the next 3-5 days.
- 3 schools has been identified in Hamirpur, UP; our team is working on and ready all government approvals for the construction work.
- In all these schools, Sewa will be building overhead tank for water provision, wash basin unit. Building a new septic tank for the toilet units.

Menstrual Health and Awareness for Adolescent girls

Conducted menstrual camps for adolescent girls in schools across Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh Beneficiary Outreach: 616

Key Activities:

• Awareness to students on women's health and hygiene.; Awareness on menstrual hygiene through educational videos and other collateral.

- Discussions on menstrual health & biological changes that happen to a girl upon puberty.
- We had beneficiaries interact with our volunteer/gynecologist to answer all their fears and queries about puberty and menstruation.
- Talk about the various myths in the society so that girls face puberty with positive mind set.
- Distributed reusable cloth sanitary napkins, These are eco friendly, washable & reusable for up to 2 yrs.

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64 transgender beneficiaries empowered across Karnataka, West Bengal, Telangana

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- Karnataka 20 transgender beneficiaries trained in operating, maintenance & sales of garlic peeling machines.
- West Bengal Training of 30 beneficiaries in tailoring & beautician training and 4 beneficiaries in paper plate manufacturing unit.
- **Telangana** 10 beneficiaries trained in running a food truck & food center.

Impact of SHE & CAF programs across Viratnagar

- 15+ schools, 116 new toilets, 5223+ student beneficiaries
- 1500+ adolescent girl students educated on menstrual health and hygiene
- 300+ students given yoga and self defense training
- 190+ women empowered through skill development training and earning a sustainable livelihood. programs included tailoring & embroidery, blue pottery and block printing

With the success of our model village in Virantnagar, we are taking these learnings to implement model villages across other states in India.

These efforts include: providing sanitation facilities for students in schools, promoting menstrual awareness and education, distributing cloth sanitary napkins, providing skill development opportunities for covid impacted women and girls, hosting self defense workshops, and providing health check-ups for women and girls.
