NOV KEY HIGHLIGHTS

SANITATION

- Ongoing repair and renovation work of non functional toilets in schools across Karnataka as a part of the WASH project funded by Oracle India. A total of 25 schools are being identified for WASH (activities on drinking water provision, sanitation, menstrual hygiene).
- Completed the construction of 12 toilets across 3 underprivileged schools in Jharkhand.
- Ongoing construction of 20 toilets in 5 schools across Kakinada, Andhra Pradesh and Kalasa, Karnataka
- Ongoing need analysis and due diligence across schools in Chattisgarh

MENSTRUAL HYGIENE & AWARENESS

- Menstrual health and hygiene camps conducted in schools across Karnataka
- Distribution of reusable cloth sanitary napkin kits to adolescent girl students .
- Total beneficiaries covered -480.

<u>Focus Areas:</u>

- Menstrual health and awareness sessions.
- Distribution of reusable cloth sanitary napkins to girl students from class 7 10 student beneficiaries.

SHE-CAF

- Total beneficiaries 4008
- Beneficiaries undergoing the training: 569.
- Beneficiaries who completed their trainings and got jobs/self employed: 2288. New registrations received: 911.
- Target Beneficiaries<u>:</u> Covid impacted women from Urban, Rural & Tribal areas, Transgender community.
- Ongoing programs: Regional skill development(Kalamkari painting, block printing, jute & wooden art, arni embroidery etc), weaver empowerment, micro enterprise, livestock rearing, fitness & yoga certification, skill development trainings(computer, beauty, tailoring, mehendi art, digital literacy etc), tribal livelihood, Agri farming etc.



NOV KEY HIGHLIGHTS

DEEPAVALI CELEBRATIONS

- Our SHE team joyously celebrated the Festival of Lights alongside our SHE and SHE-CAF beneficiaries in Jharkhand, Karnataka, Chhattisgarh, Rajasthan, and Tamil Nadu. The festivities included the worship of Goddess Lakshmi, the distribution of prasad crafted by our beneficiaries, and the soulful recitation of bhajans. Around 200+ beneficiaries actively participated in these celebrations.
- In the spirit of this occasion, several new programs were launched, showcasing our commitment to continuous growth and development. Among these initiatives were a tailoring program in Saharsa, Bihar, and the establishment of a micro-enterprise in Hosur. Moreover, workshops on painting diyas were organized in schools, where our SHE-CAF beneficiaries shared their creative talents, imparting artistic skills to young minds.
- These inclusive events go beyond mere celebration; they cultivate a deep sense of community among our beneficiaries. This shared experience not only strengthens collaboration and teamwork but also lays the foundation for valuable networks that persist during and after their training.







SHE-CAF FOR MARGINALISED COMMUNITY

Our initiatives have effectively empowered women from marginalized and minority communities by offering thorough training, establishing market connections, and facilitating job placements.

The project involves diverse programs, covering courses like tailoring and embroidery, mehendi and makeup artistry, livestock rearing as well as digital literacy.

Moreover, it includes the establishment of microenterprises, such as the introduction of garlic peeling machines and push carts for vendors, fostering sustainable economic opportunities.

SANITATION - TOILET CONSTRUCTION



Completed toilet construction in schools across Jharkhand; Ongoing sanitation work across schools in Karnataka and Anhra Pradesh ; need analysis in Chattisgarh

- Completed the construction of 12 toilets in rural Govt schools Jharkhand.
- Ongoing construction of 20 toilets in Kakinada, Andhra Pradesh and Kalasa, Karnataka, ; This project funded by individual donors Ramalakshmi ji, Raefael Campo - Detriot chapter, Prathibha Nethikunta - LA chapter and few donors from LA chapter.
- Survey, need analysis and due diligence in schools across Chattisgarh. This project is funded by Ekam USA and Sewa north jersey chapter.
- In all these schools, Sewa is building overhead tank for water provision, wash basin unit, building a new septic tank for the toilet units.
- Ongoing repairs and renovation of existing non functional toilets across 25 identified schools in Karnataka. In each of these identified schools, Sewa is also installing hand wash units.

Menstrual Health & Awareness, distribution of reusable napkin kits

Conducted menstrual health & awareness camps for adolescent girls in schools across Karnataka Beneficiary Outreach: 480

Key Activities:

• Awareness to students on women's health and hygiene.;Awareness on menstrual hygiene through educational videos and other collateral.

- Awareness to students on importance of WASH water, menstrual hygiene and sanitation,
- We had beneficiaries interact with our volunteer/gynecologist to answer all their fears and queries about puberty and menstruation.
- Talk about the various myths in the society so that girls face puberty with positive mind set.
- Distributed reusable cloth sanitary napkins, These are eco friendly, washable & reusable for up to 2 yrs.
